The MOE Annual School Survey

Each year the Ministry of Education surveys the schools of Kiribati to gather data about the pupils, teachers, facilities, grounds and resources at each school. Additional data is also collected from the National Statistics Office (population data and projections) and the Ministry of Finance (financial and budget figures).

The Ministry of Education is grateful to School Head Teachers and Principals for providing school data through survey forms completed each year. These data are used by the Ministry of Education for the purposes of planning and monitoring the effectiveness of education sector development programmes, as well as day-to-day operational management of the education sector.

School survey data once received at MOE is collated and analysed using the Kiribati Education Management Information System (KEMIS). KEMIS is a rich database of information about the schools, students and teachers of the Kiribati education system. If you would like more information about the Kiribati education system, or more detailed information about an aspect of the system, please contact the Secretary of Education's office at the Ministry of Education.

Section One: National Summary Statistics

Our Schools

There are four types of schools operating in the formal education system of Kiribati: Primary Schools (PS), Junior Secondary Schools (JSS), Combined Junior and Senior Secondary Schools (CS), and Senior Secondary Schools (SSS).

Currently formal education commences in Primary schools at Class One, for children aged six years. Primary schooling continues for six years, to Class Six.

Secondary education follows after Primary schooling and continues for three (to Form 3), six (to Form 6), or, for a small number, seven years (to Form 7). The purpose of secondary education is to expand knowledge of subjects already studied at primary school including literature, science, mathematics, social studies, commerce and other subjects essential for physical and intellectual development and to prepare students for specialised skills training.

In the Secondary school system, there are 3 categories of schools:

Junior Secondary Schools: This is a continuation of free education from Primary schools and students are promoted automatically into these schools. Each island has its own JSS which is run by the Government. The Universal Junior Secondary Schooling program initially started in 1998 with four schools established on different islands. By 2002 all islands had one JSS and Primary students on each island are absorbed into that school system. JSS starts from Form One and completes at Form Three. At the end of Form Three, students have to sit for exams in order to get places at much higher forms. Since 2002 to date, there are 24 well established JSS in Kiribati.

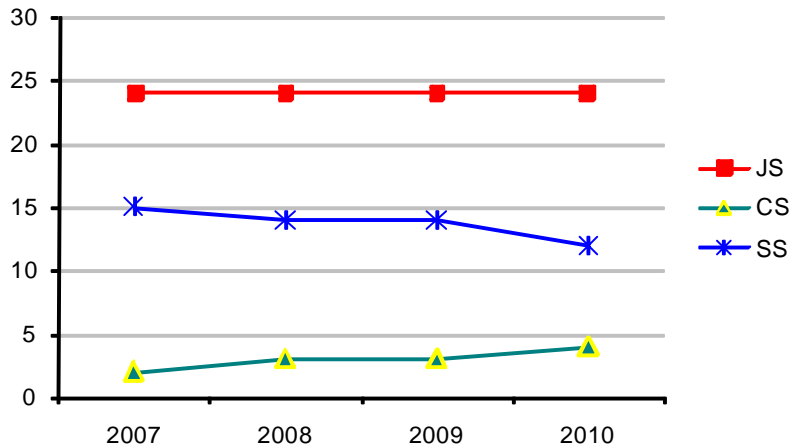
Senior Secondary Schools: With the increase in number of JSS established, Senior Secondary Schools emerged. As students from Primary were slowly being absorbed into JSS, Secondary Schools which used to have Form One to Six or even Seven slowly started phasing out Form One to Three. This year there are 12 registered Senior Secondary Schools in Kiribati, starting from Form Four to either Form Six or Seven. Three of these are run by Government and twelve are operated by Churches.

Combined Junior/Senior Secondary Schools: These are schools which still have students at lower levels of Secondary as well as higher forms. There are now four schools of such type and both are run by Churches. Despite the fact that they are church owned, their Junior Secondary subjects particularly at Form Three are still controlled by Government as are all the other Junior Secondary School subjects. However, these are still registered as Senior Secondary Schools even though they have aspects of a Junior Secondary School.

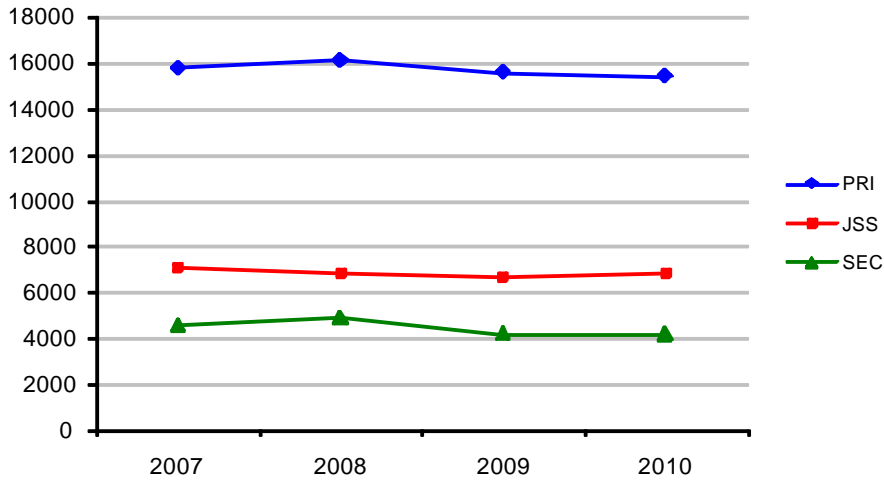

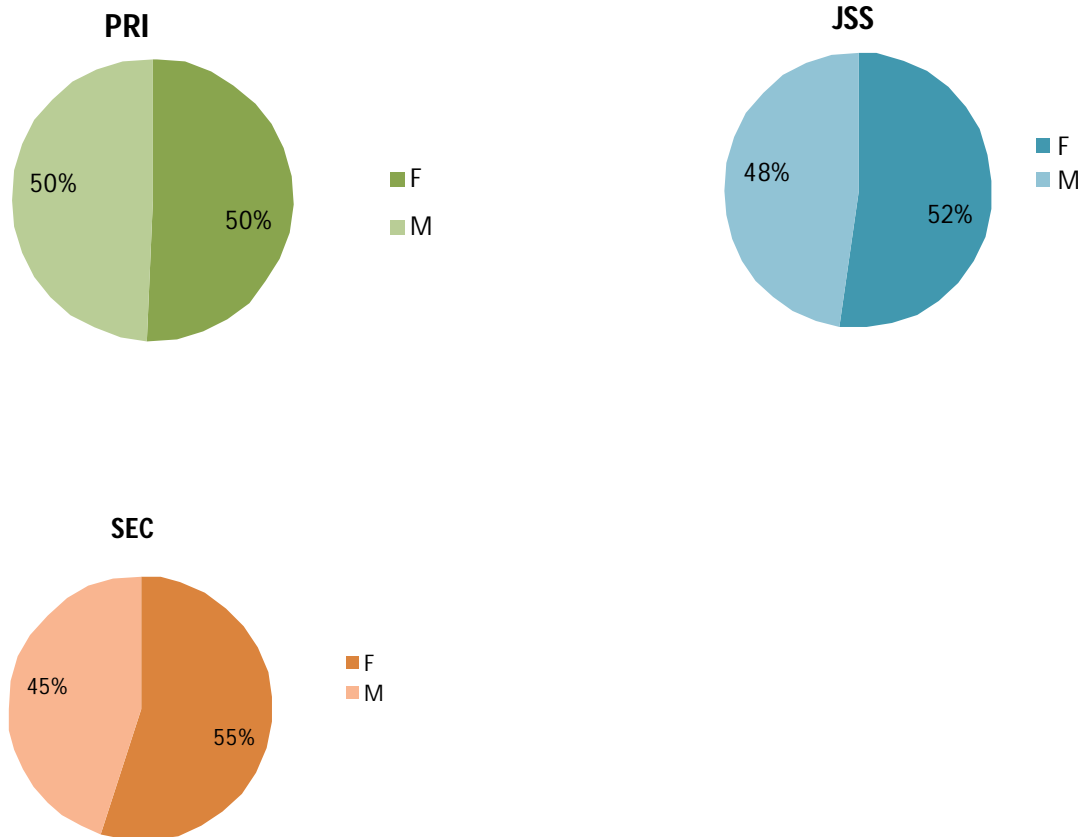

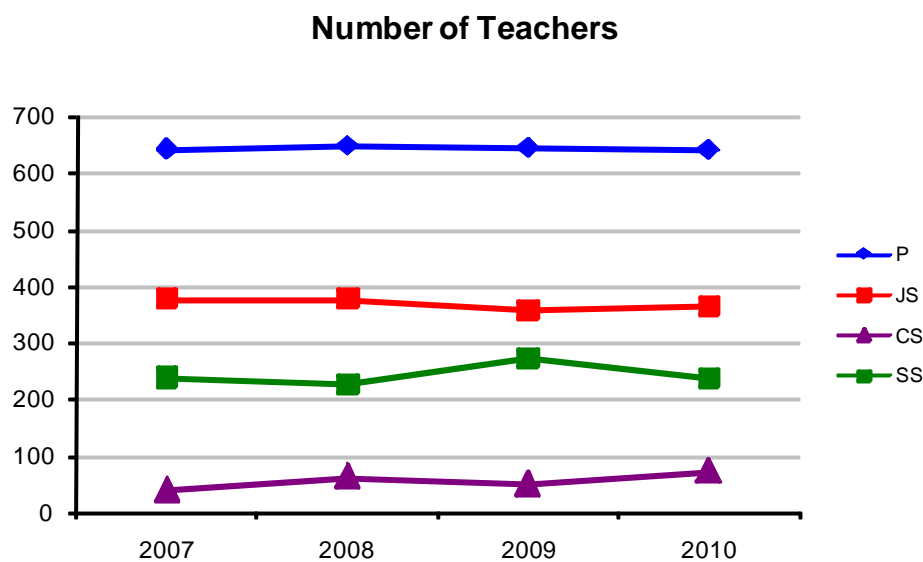

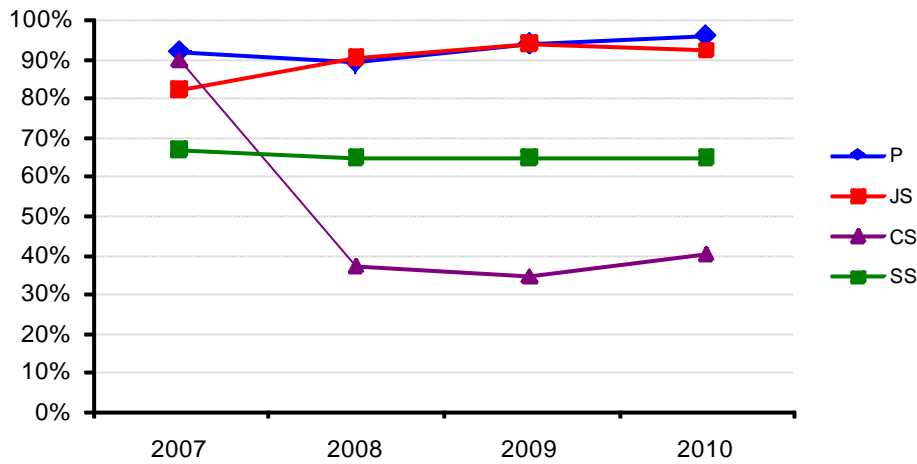

Chart of Teacher Numbers by School Type, 2007 - 2010.



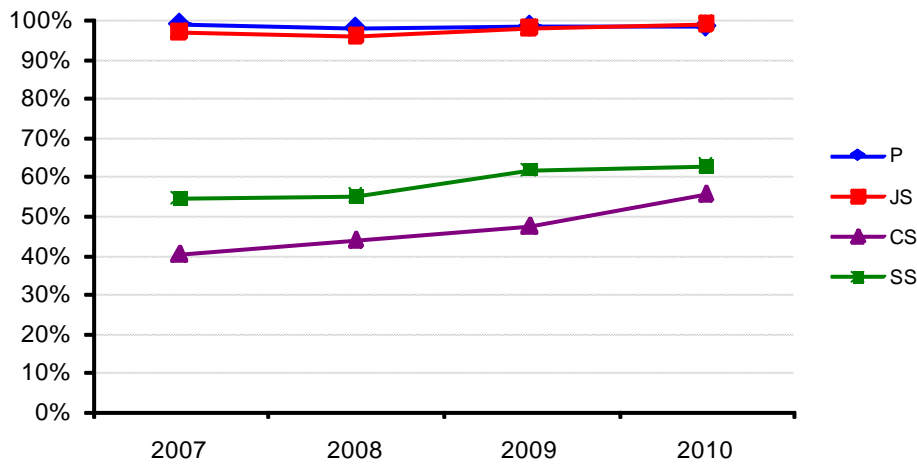
Changes in Proportion of Teachers with Minimum Required Academic Qualifications by School Type, 2007 - 2010.

Percentage of Qualified Teachers



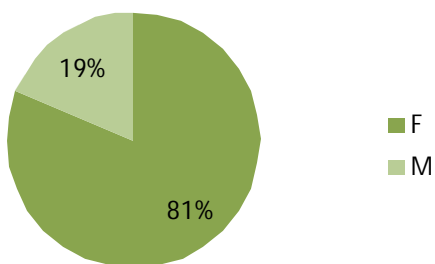
Changes in the Proportion of Teachers who Have Completed Teacher Training by School Type, 2007 - 2010

Percentage of Certified Teachers

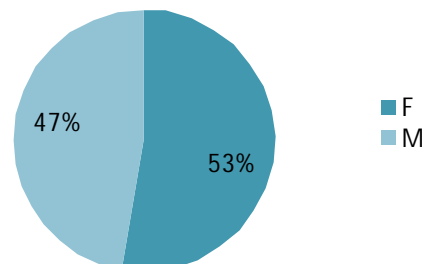


Proportion of Teachers who are Female by School Type, 2010.

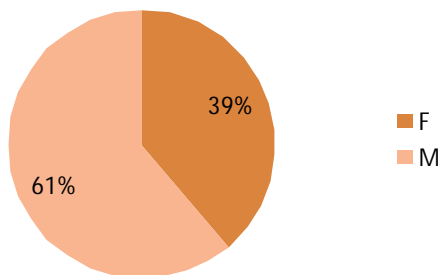

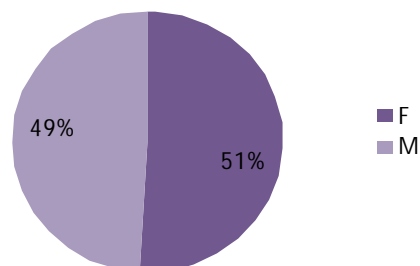
Junior Secondary School Teachers

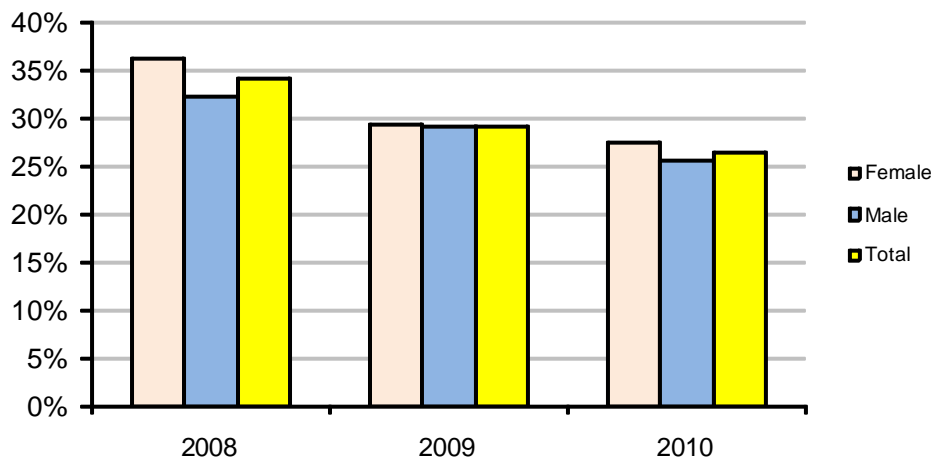

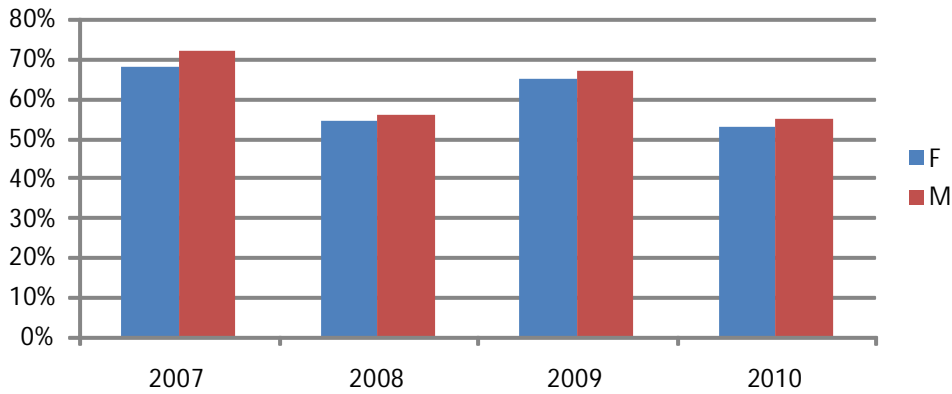
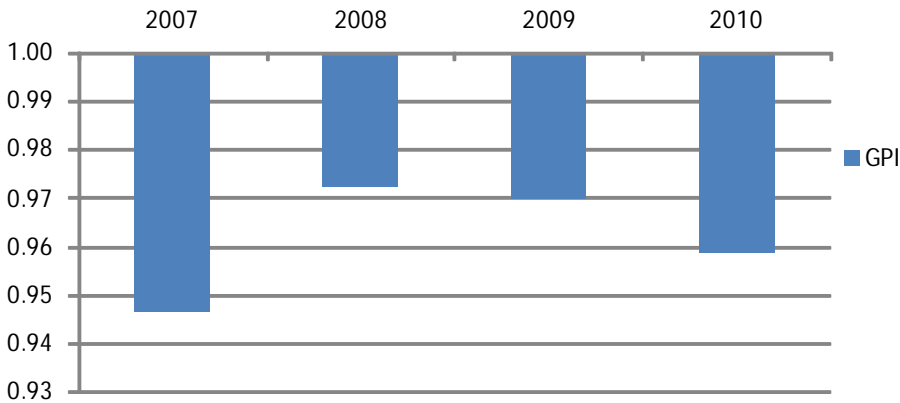


Chart of GPI Changes in Percentage of New Entrants into Primary School who have attended Early Childhood Education Programs, 2007 - 2010.

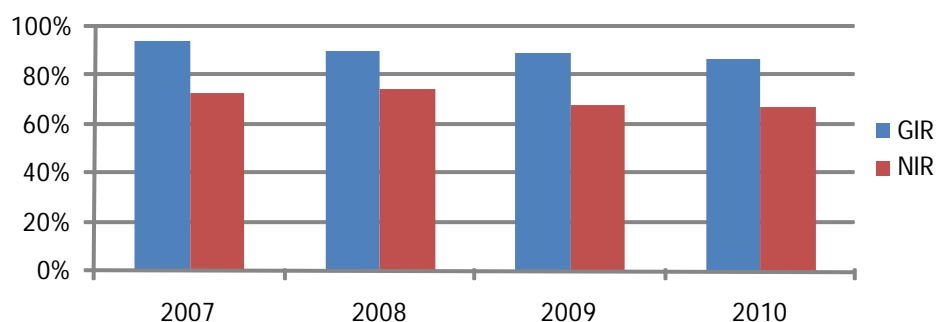

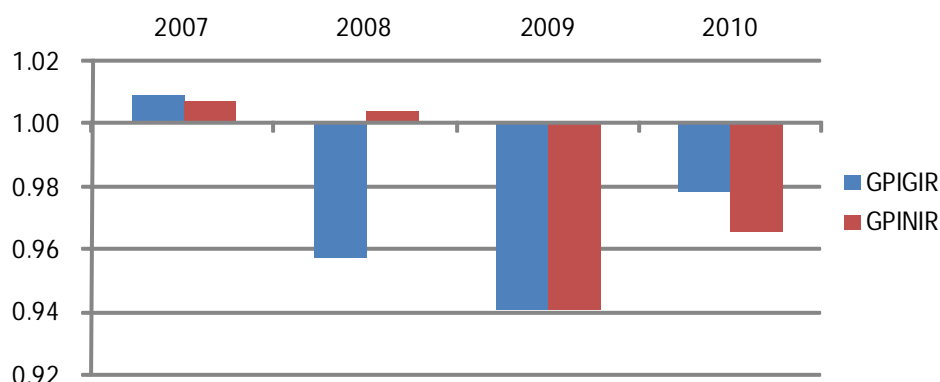
Chart of GIR and NIR, 2007 - 2010.

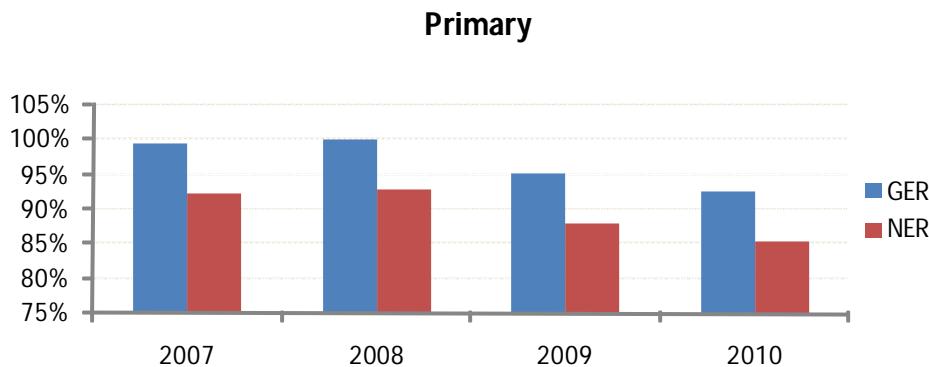

Chart of GPI Changes in Primary GER and NER, 2007 - 2010.

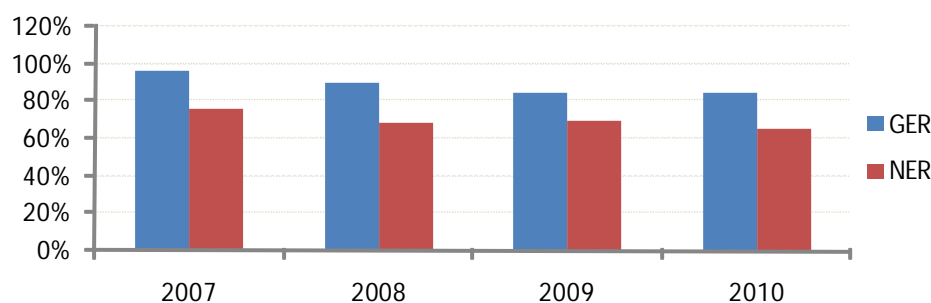

Chart of GER and NER for Junior Secondary Students, 2007 - 2010.

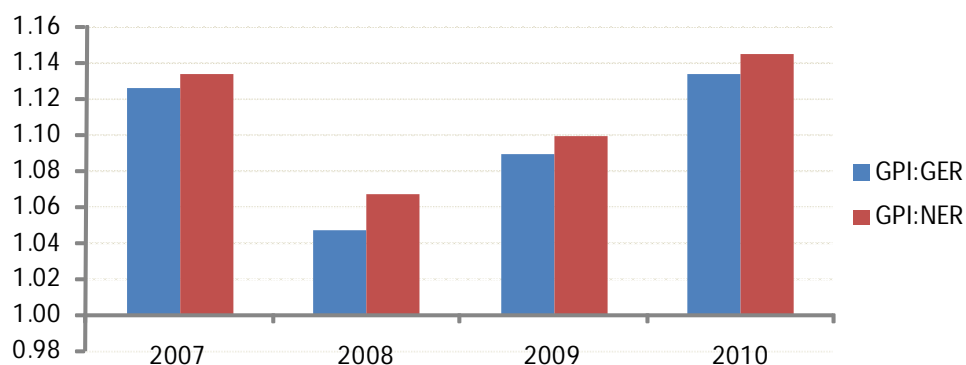

Chart of GPI Changes in Junior Secondary GER and NER, 2007 - 2010.

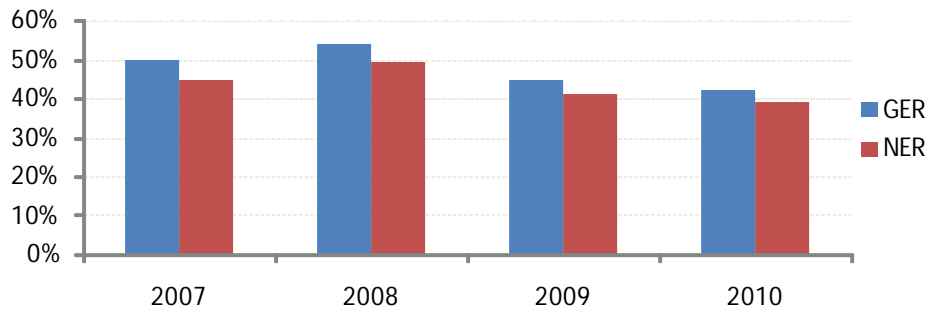

Gender Parity Index for Senior Secondary GER and NER, 2007 - 2010.

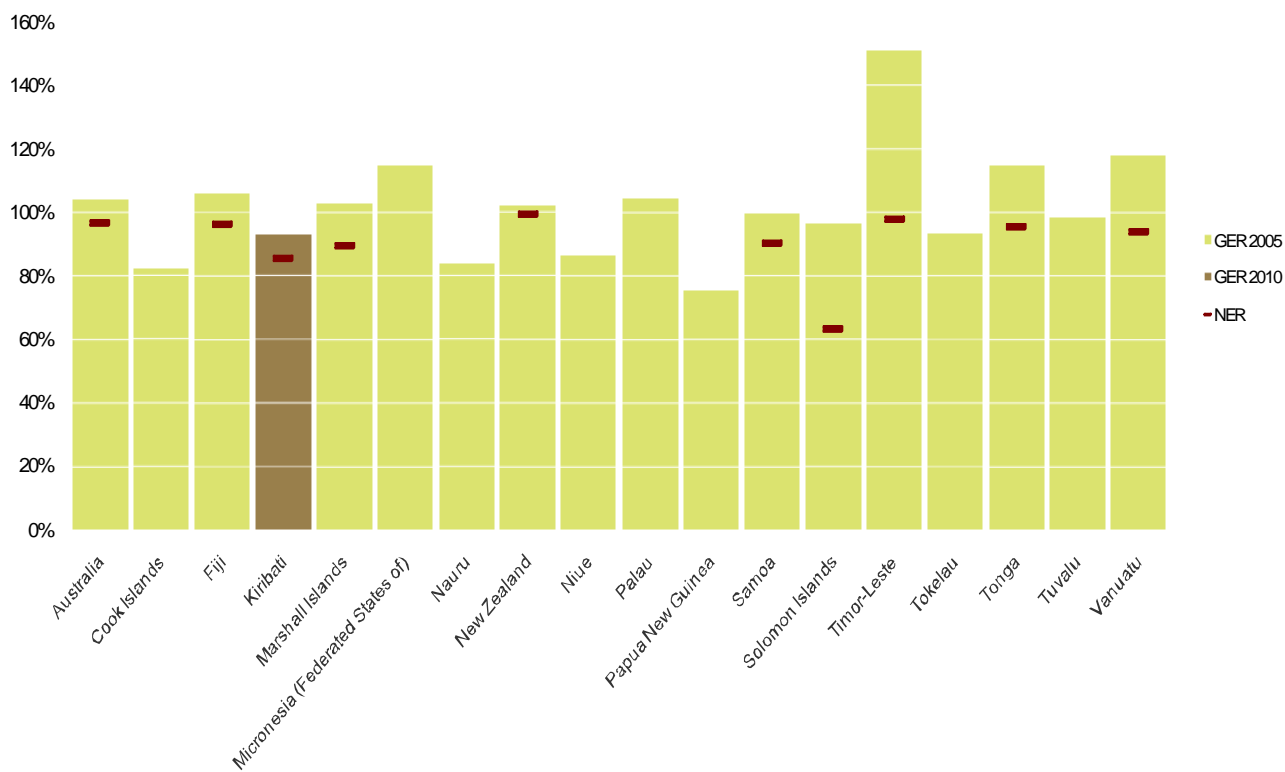

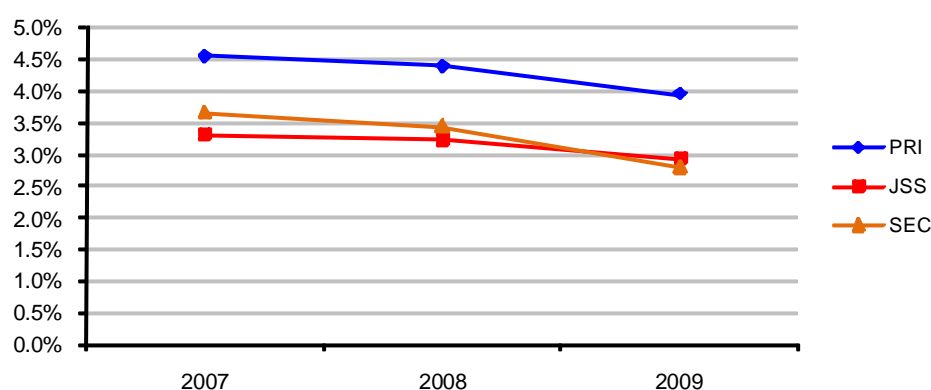

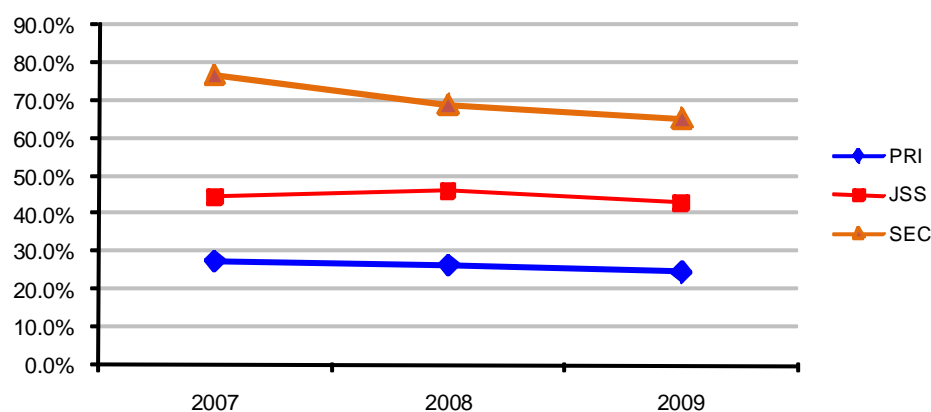
Chart of Expenditure on Primary, Junior Secondary and Senior Secondary Education as Percentage of Gross National Product, 2007- 2009.

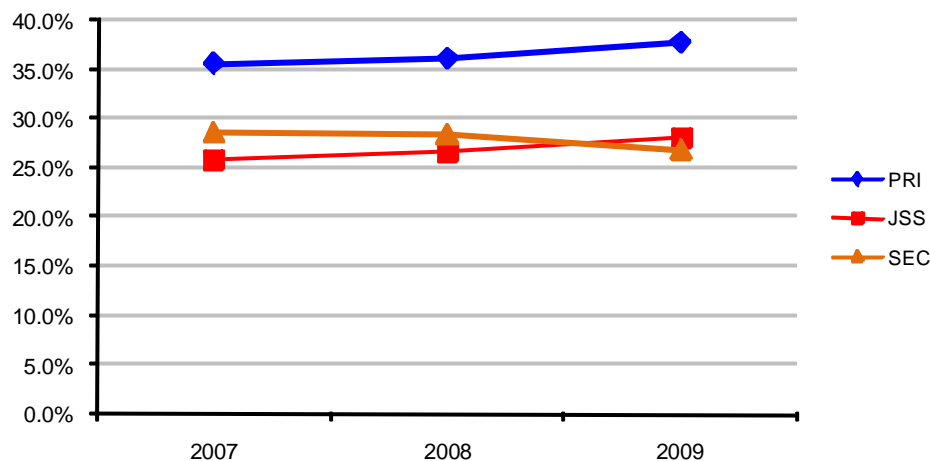

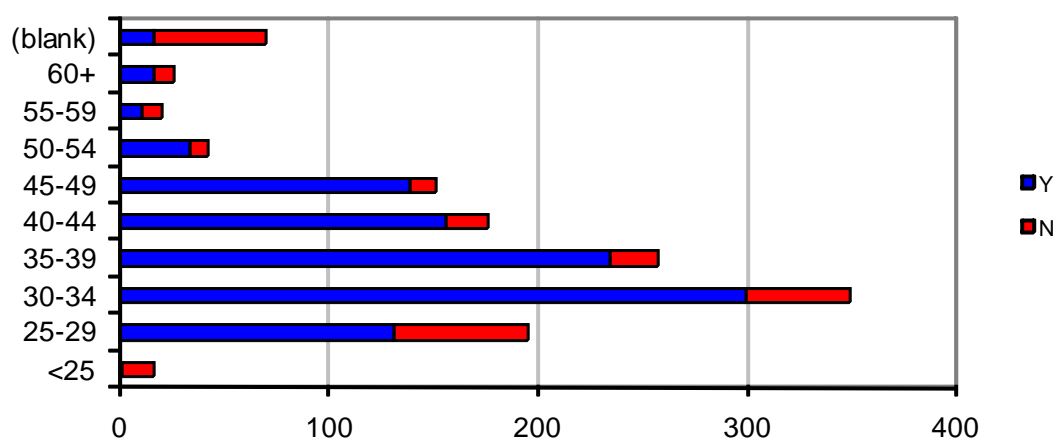
Percentage of Qualified Teachers (all school types) by Gender, 2009 - 2010.

Chart of Proportion of Teachers who are Certified, by Age Group.

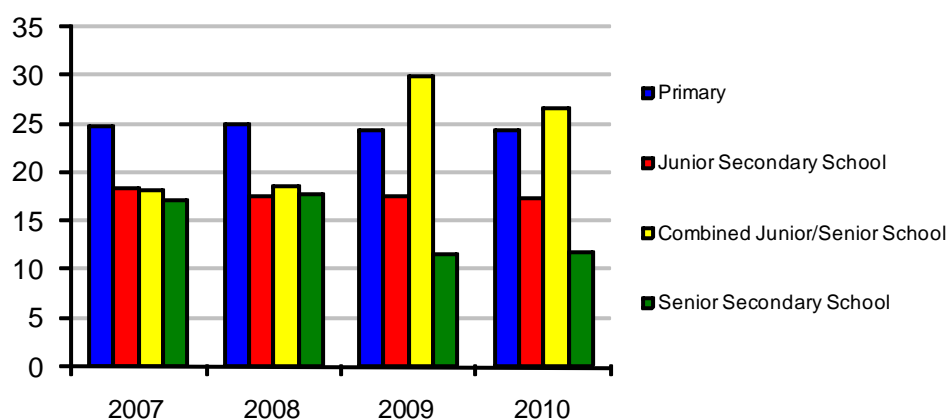

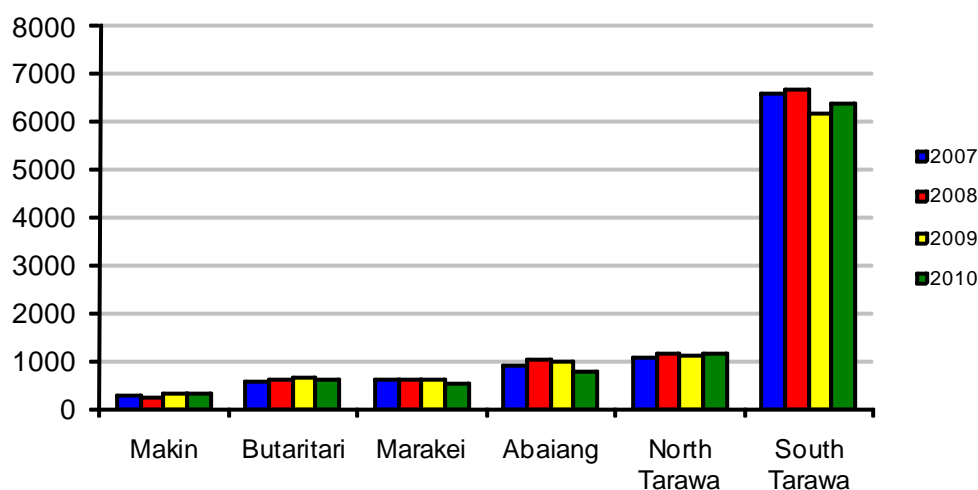

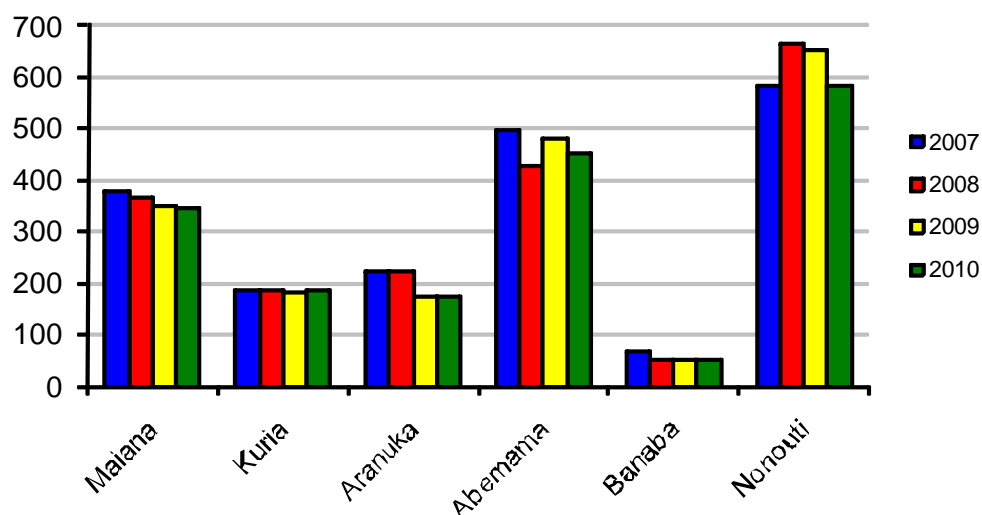

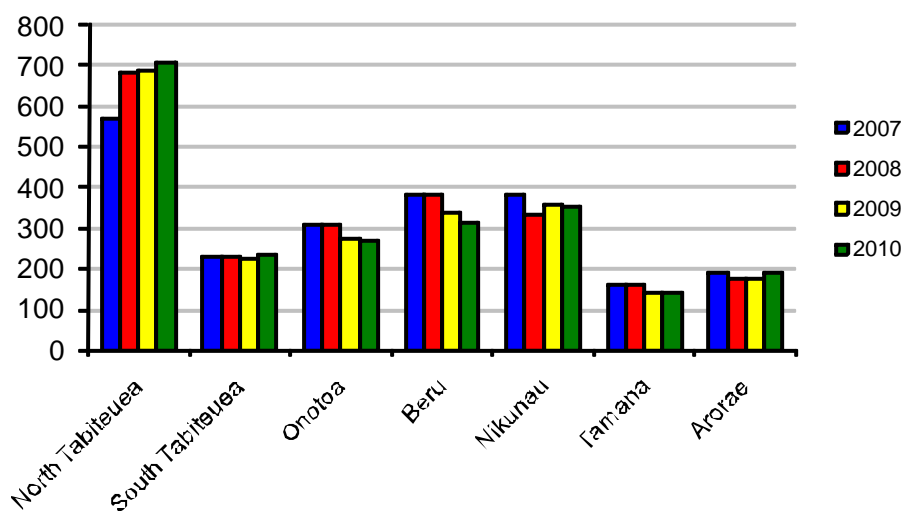

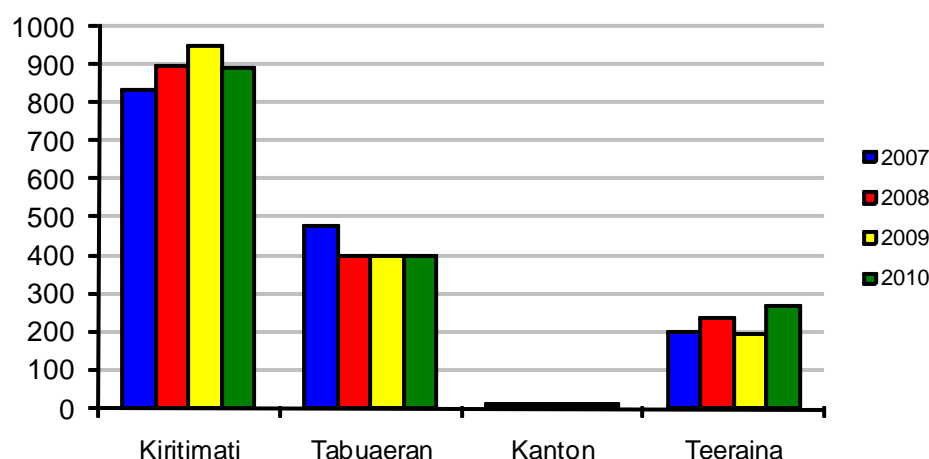

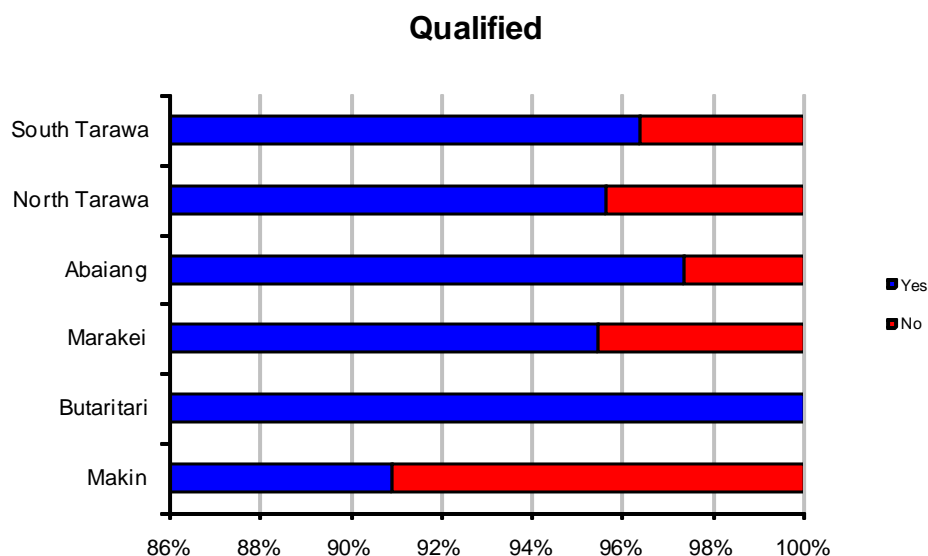

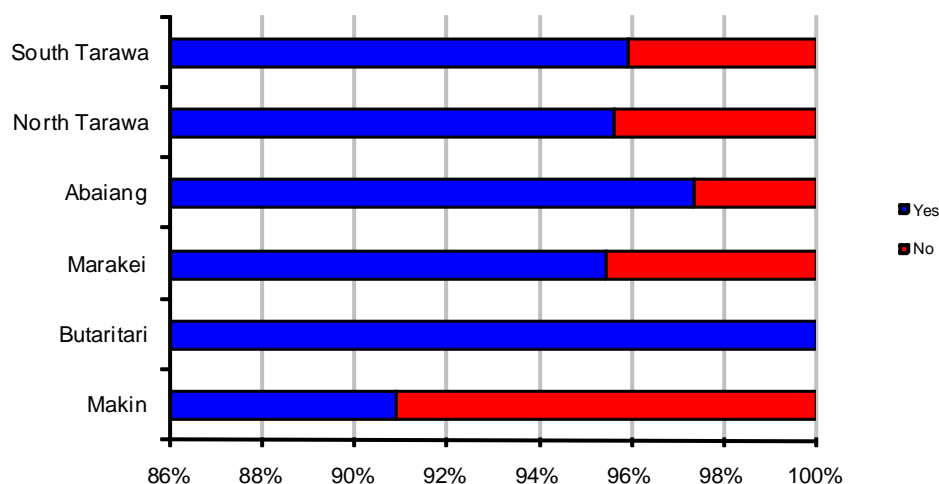

Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Primary Schools of District North, 2010.



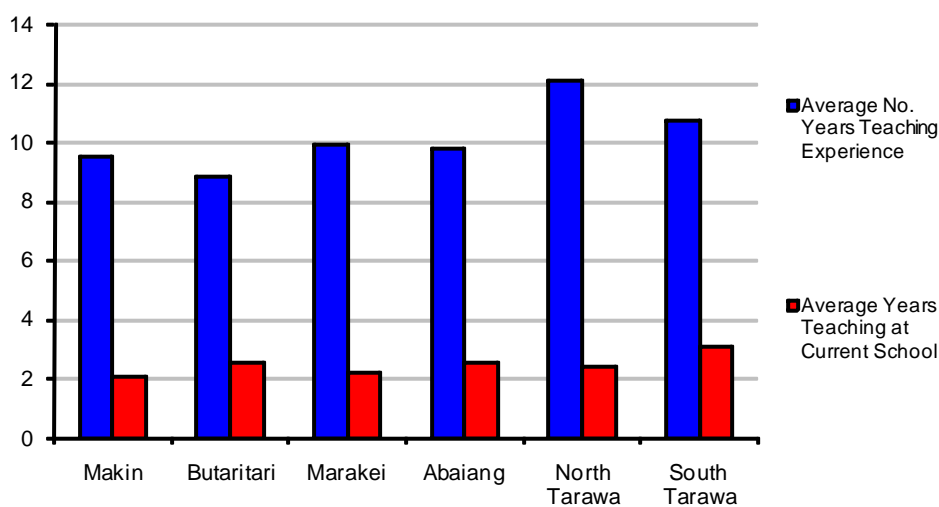

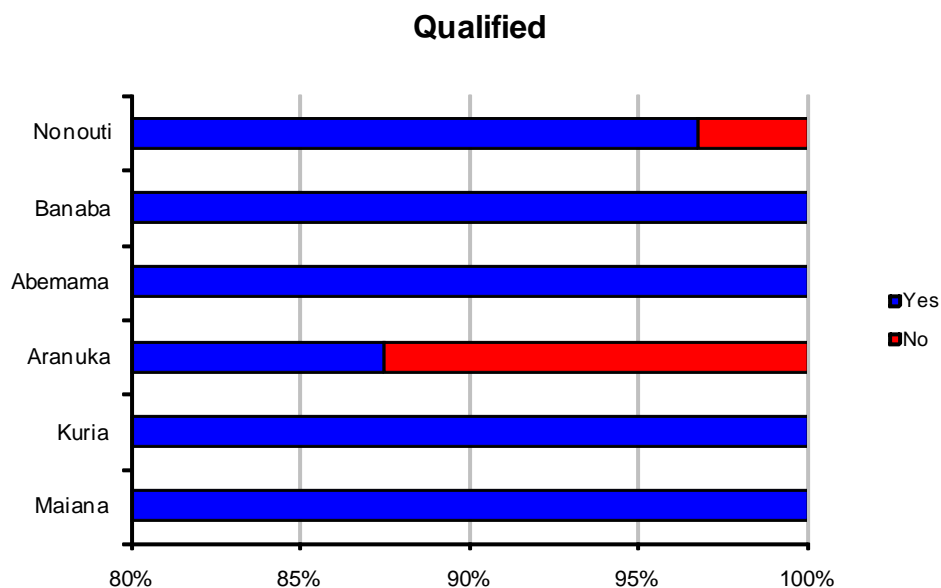

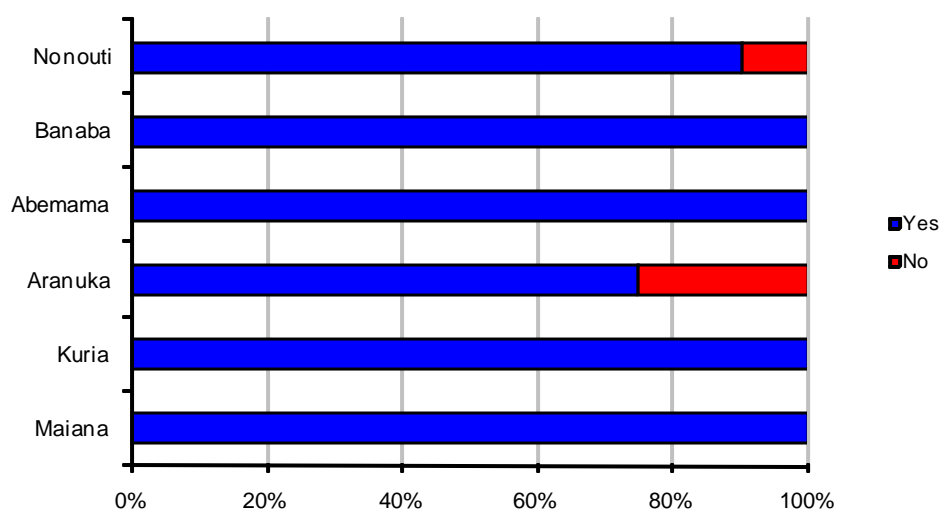

Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Primary Schools of District Central, 2010.



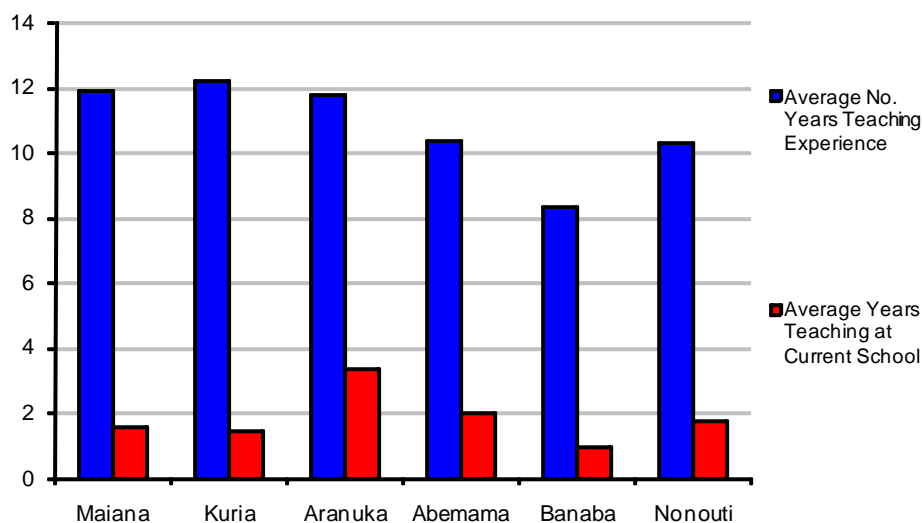

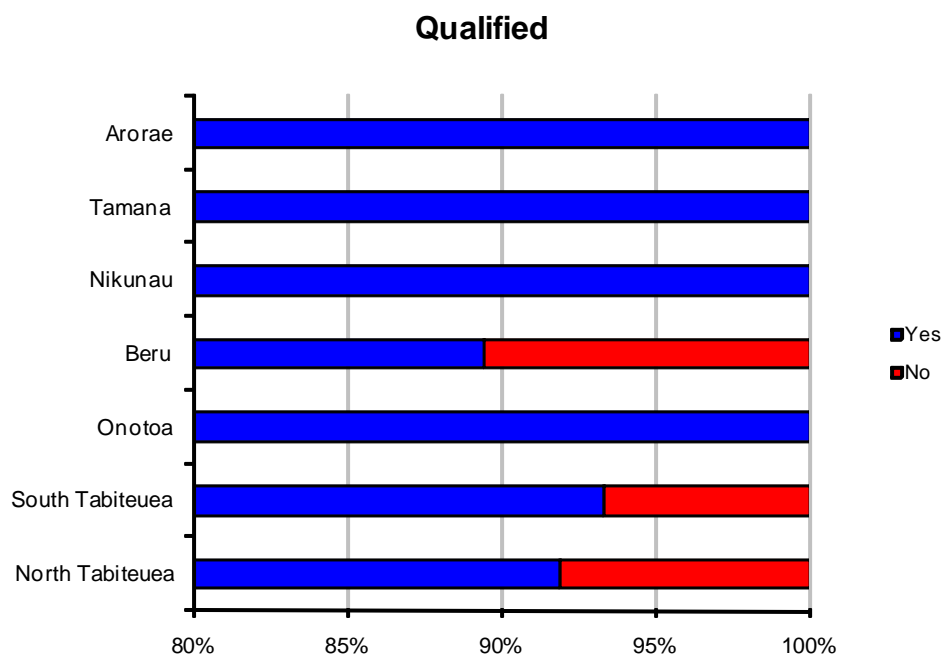

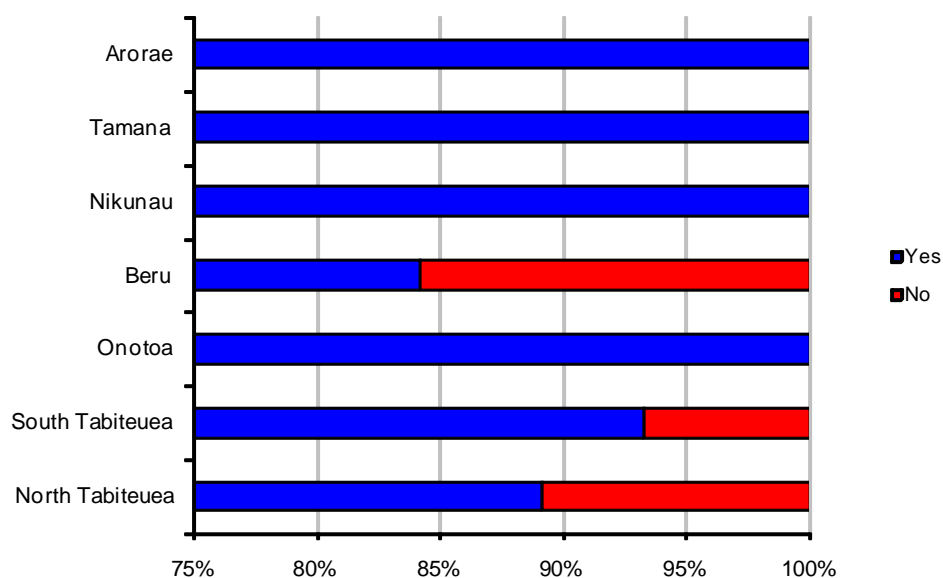

Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Primary Schools of District South, 2010.



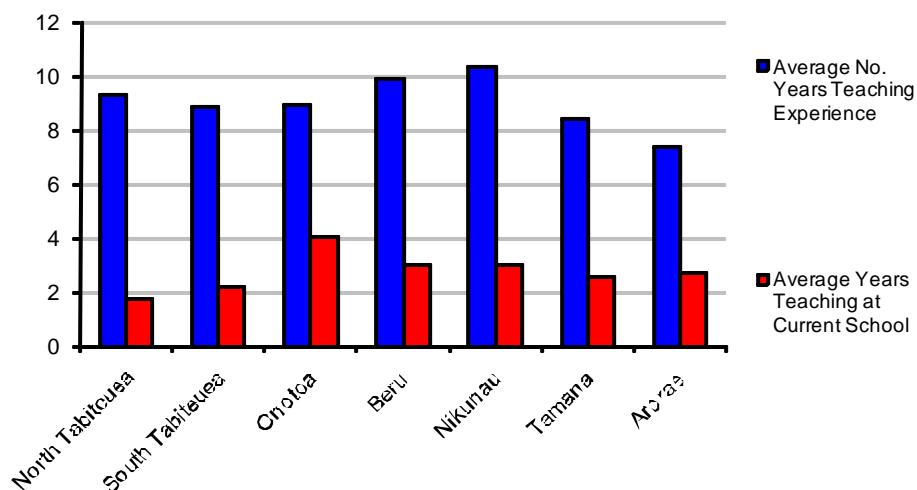

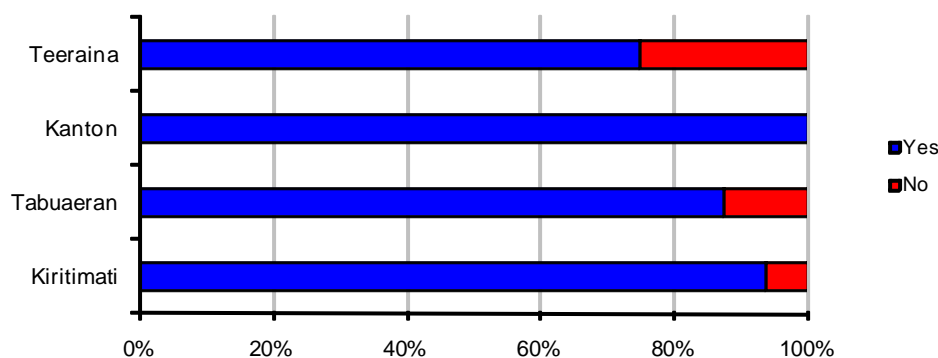

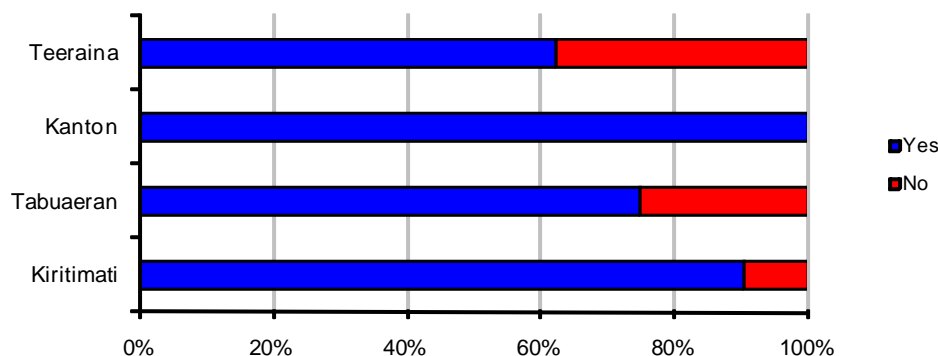

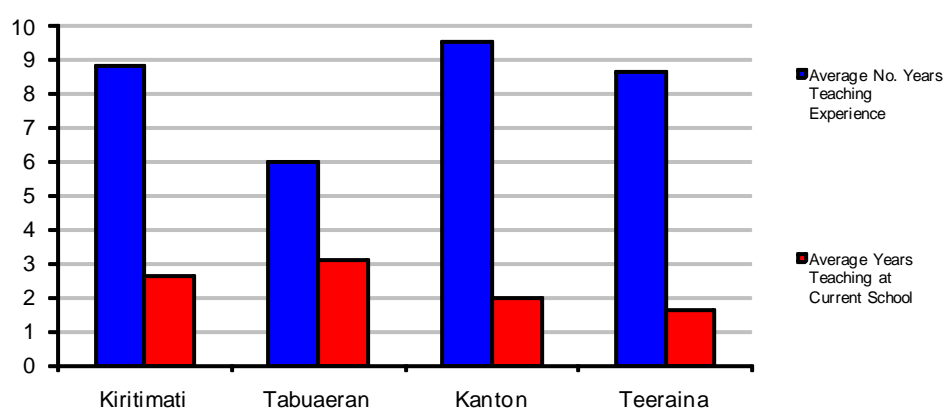

National Infrastructure Standards (NIS) for Primary Schools were revised and extended in 2006.

Classifying Schools

The Infrastructure Standards distinguish between *Urban* and *Rural* schools, where urban schools are defined as:

Schools with access to piped water, town power and waste disposal services (town sewer, septic pump-out and garbage collection).

For purposes of this analysis, South Tarawa schools are treated as Urban, all others as Rural.

The Standards also distinguish between schools based on enrolment; in 2010, these divisions are:

<i>Small</i>	Schools with up to 90 students
<i>Medium</i>	Schools with 91 and up to 180 students
<i>Large</i>	Schools with more than 180 students

NIS 1: School Grounds

1(a) **School Site** - The space provided for all purposes other than school buildings that is as a play area or school farm and garden, shall equal 2.5 times the total of the space occupied by the school buildings of all kinds.

1(b) Condition of School Grounds

Waste Disposal - All schools are to be kept clean and tidy. Rubbish is to be regularly collected and disposed of in an acceptable manner, such as removal from the school site, burning or burial. Data on waste disposal collected in 2007 was minimal and cannot be meaningfully reported upon at this time.

School Gardens – All primary schools are encouraged to keep school gardens to support the primary school curriculum and to improve the visual attractiveness of the school grounds.

Security – School Sites will be made secure in accordance with the following minimum guidelines: Urban Schools: provide appropriate security fencing to surround the school grounds.

NIS 11: Sanitation

11(a) Legal Requirement – under the NBC it is a legal requirement that all schools are provided with safe and appropriate toilet facilities. The following toilet / person ratios have been deemed appropriate for Kiribati conditions:

- 1:40 for girls;
- 1:60 for boys; and
- 1:25 for teachers in urban schools only (it is assumed that teachers in all other schools will have access to toilets at their quarters).

11(b) Appropriate Toilet Facilities – The installation of toilet facilities is encouraged at all schools in accordance with the following minimum guidelines:

- Rural Schools and Urban Schools without access to piped water- are encouraged to provide ventilated pit or composting latrines in the ratios given in 11(a). Appropriate hand washing facilities should be located in close proximity to these toilets.
- Urban Schools with access to piped water- should be encouraged to provide flushing or water seal toilets in the ratios given in 11(a). Hand washing facilities should be incorporated with these toilets.

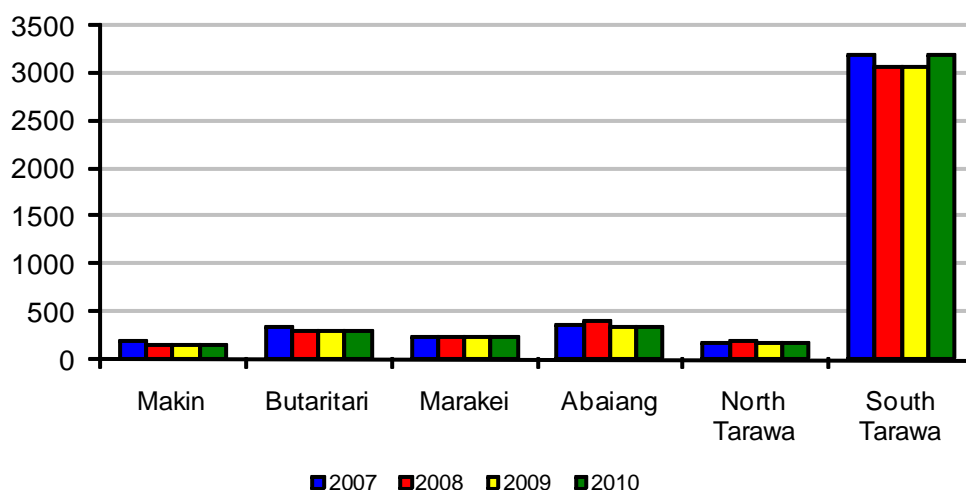

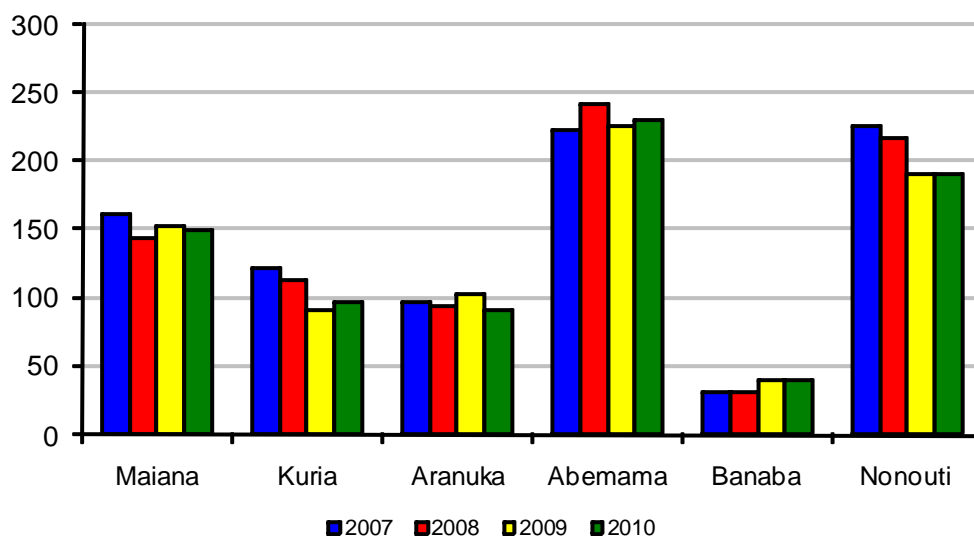

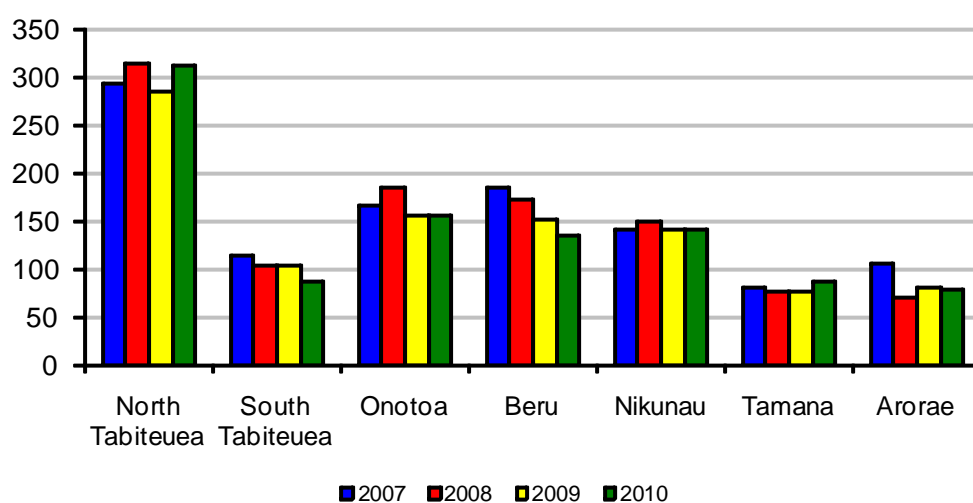

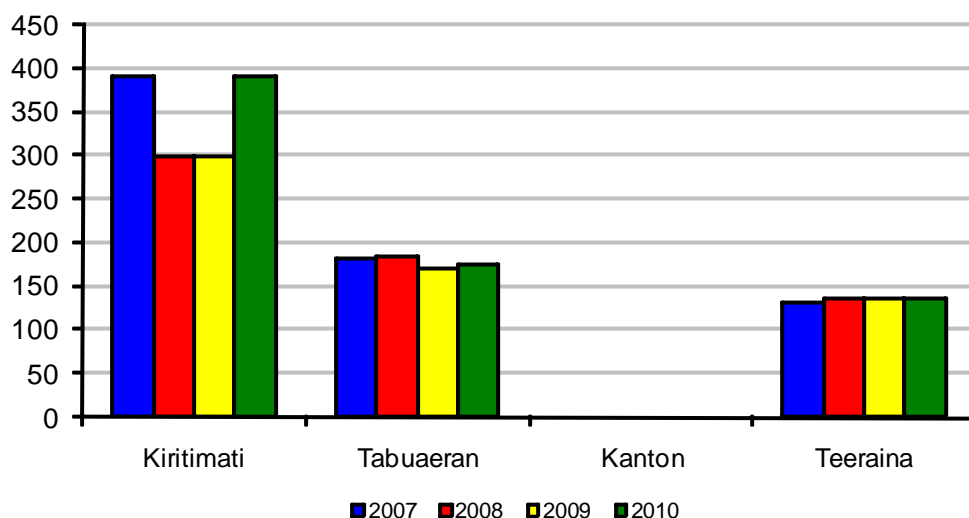

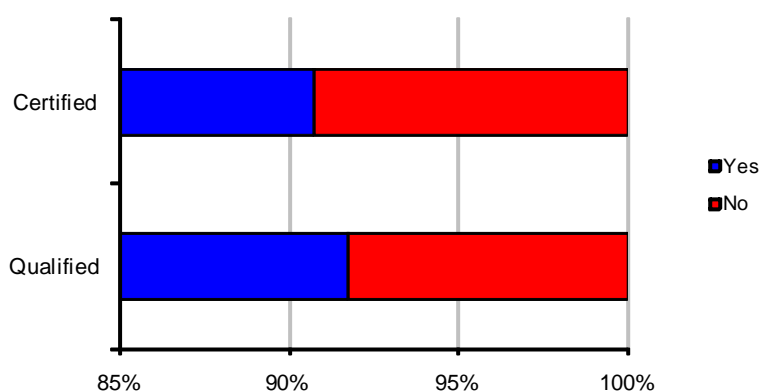

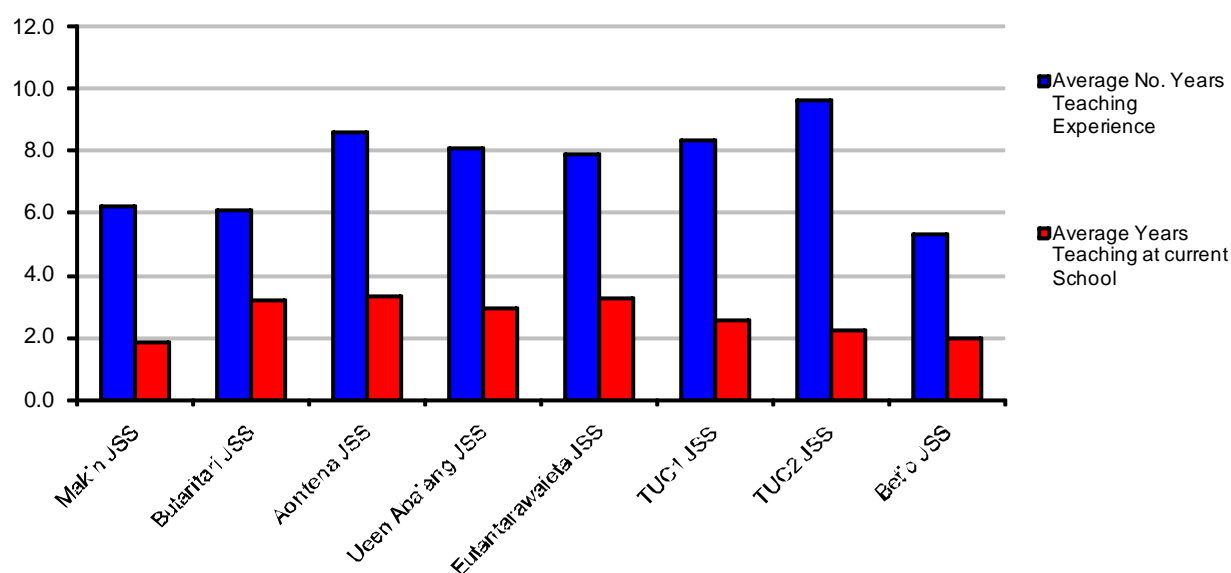
Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Junior Secondary Schools of District North.

Chart of Average Years of Teaching Experience and Average Years Teaching at Current School – District North Junior Secondary Schools.



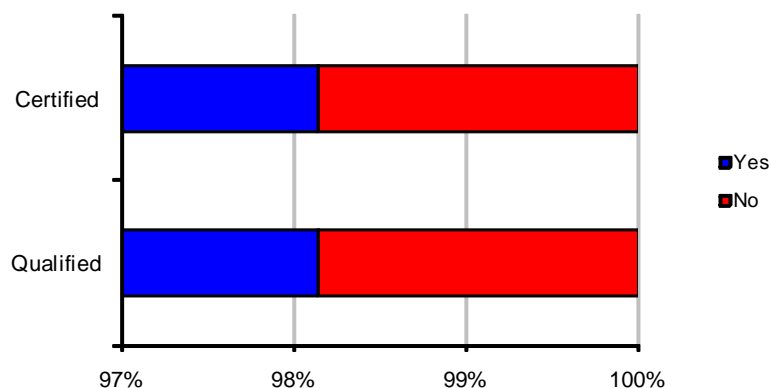

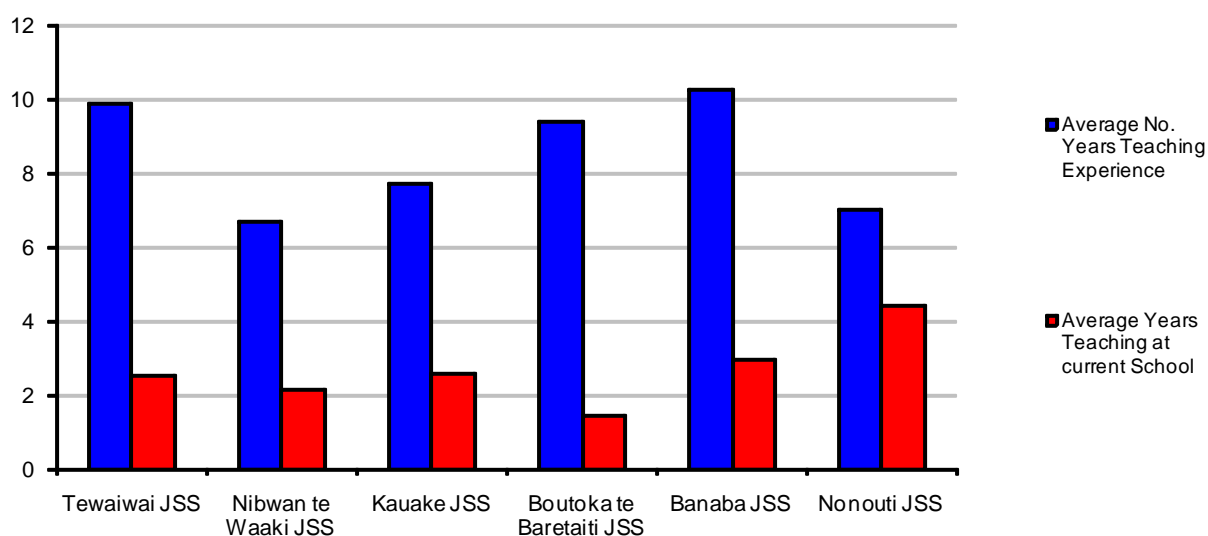

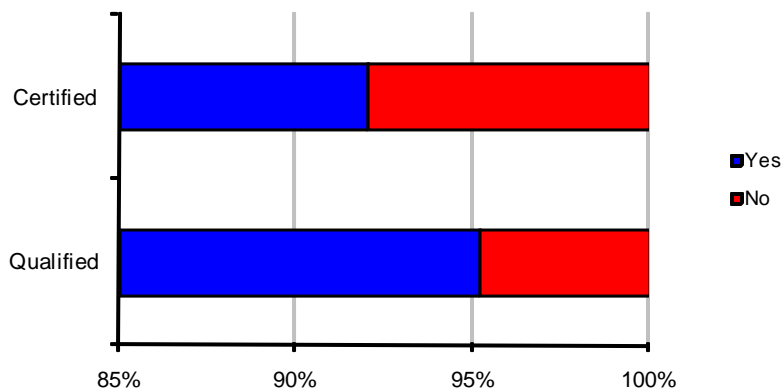

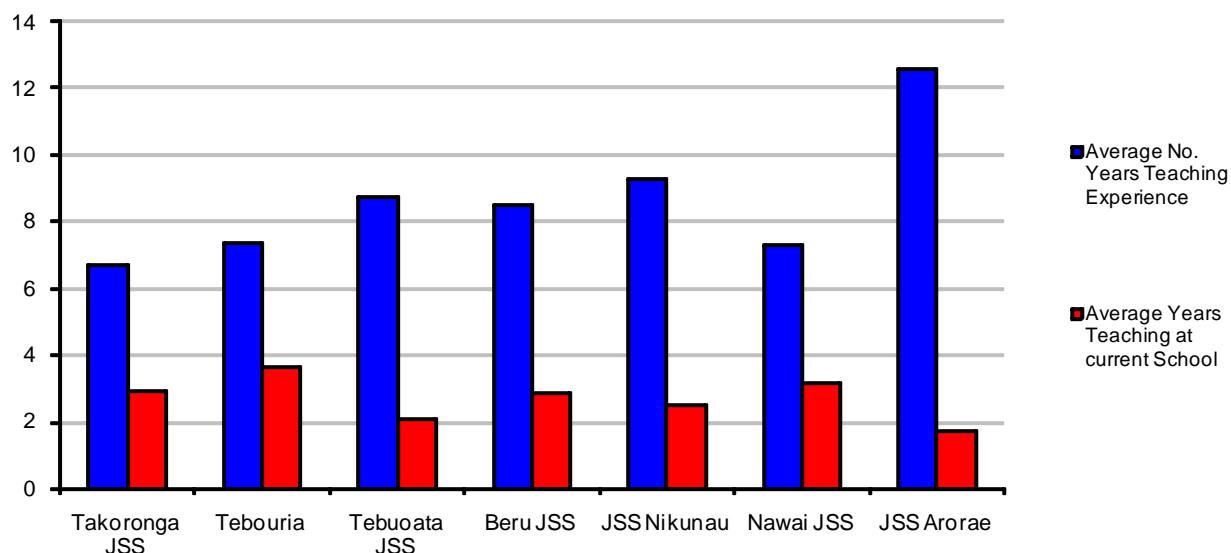
Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Junior Secondary Schools of District South.

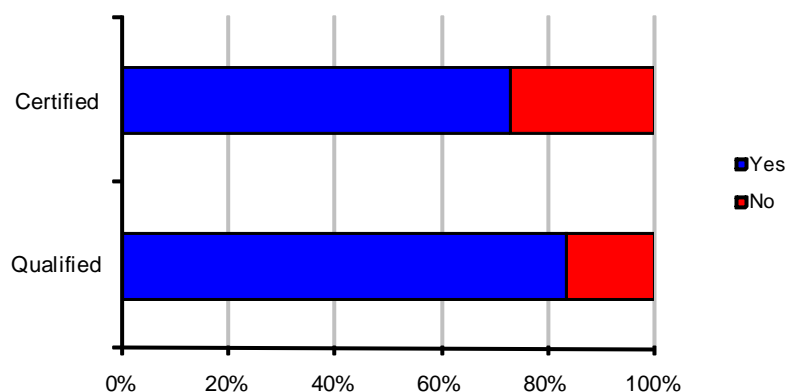

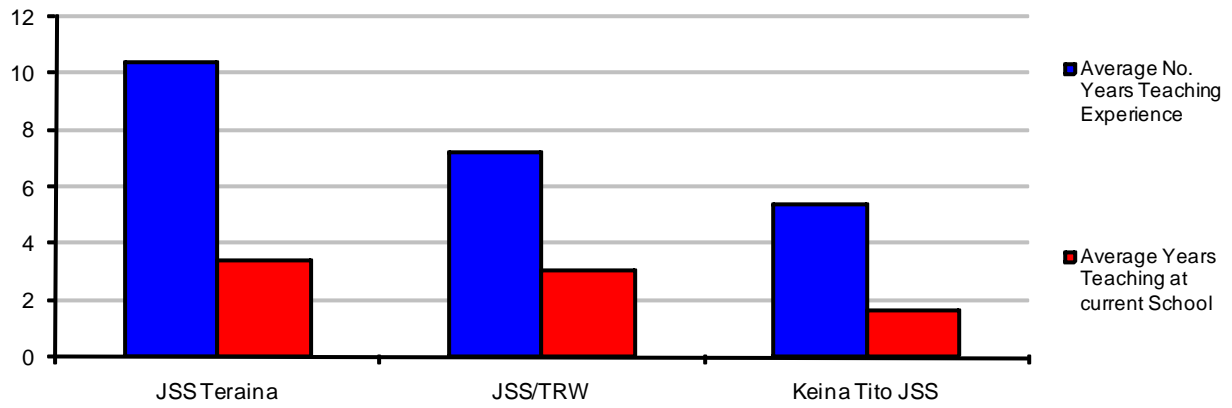
Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Junior Secondary Schools of Linnix District.

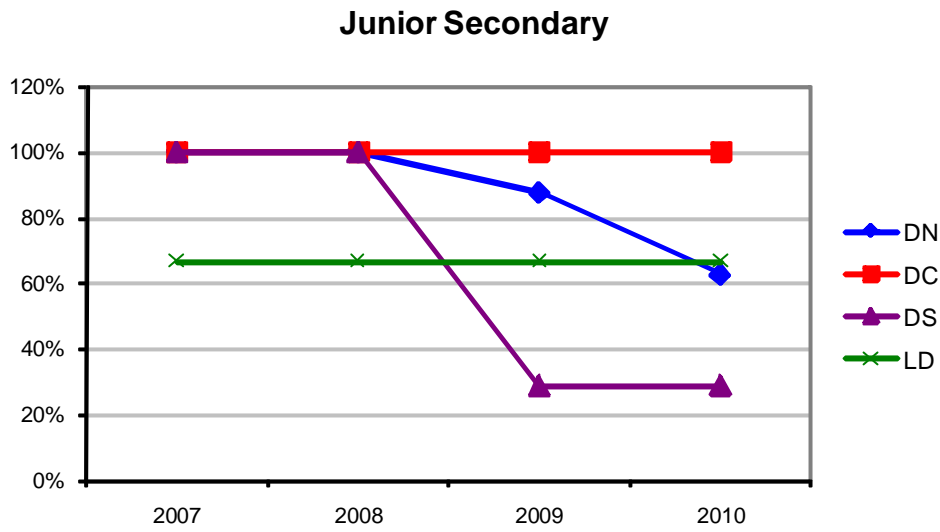

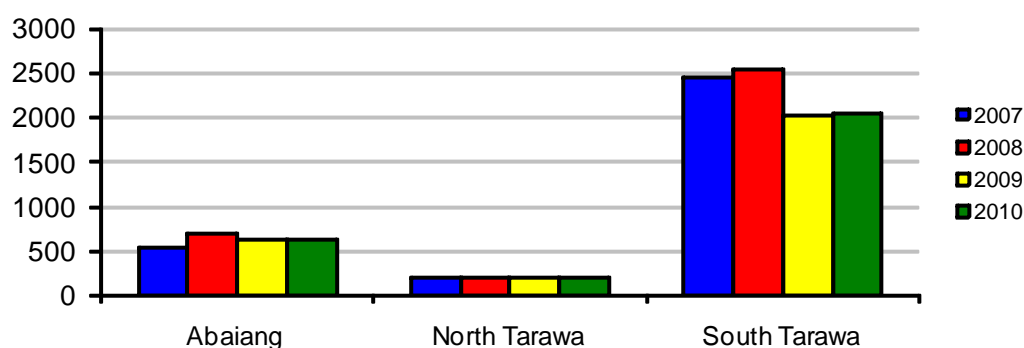

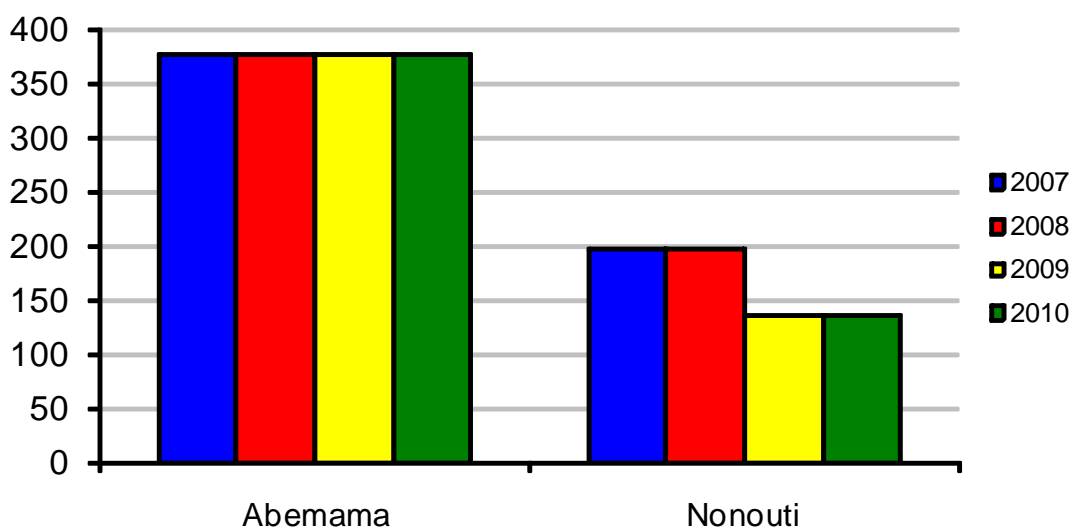

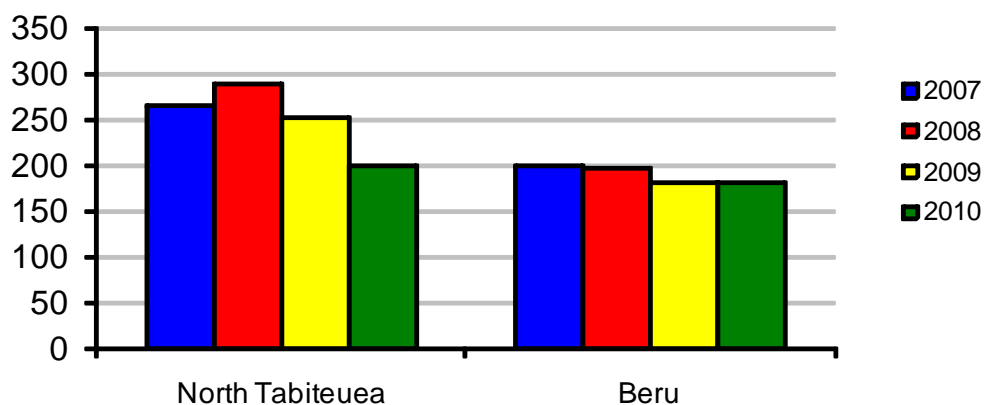

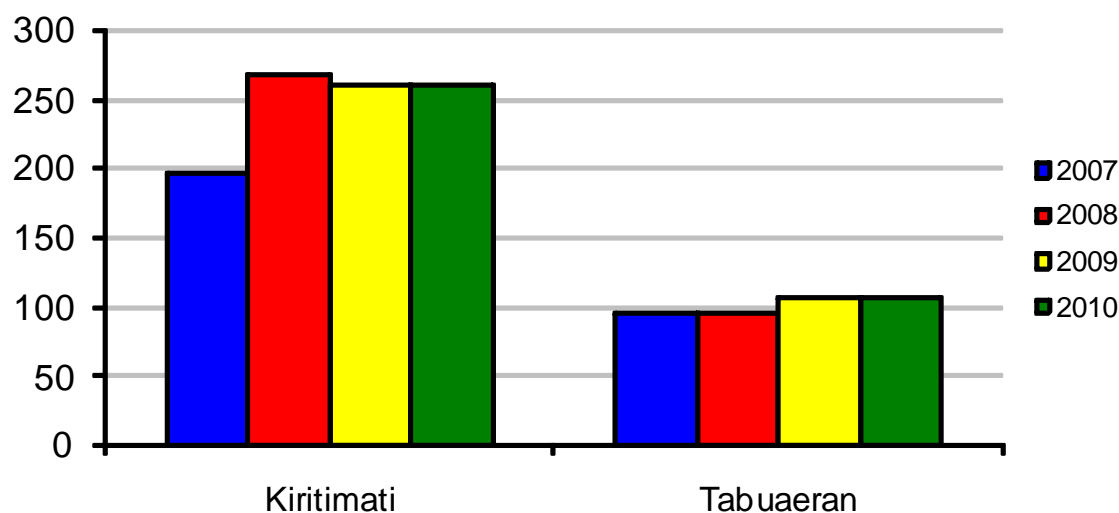

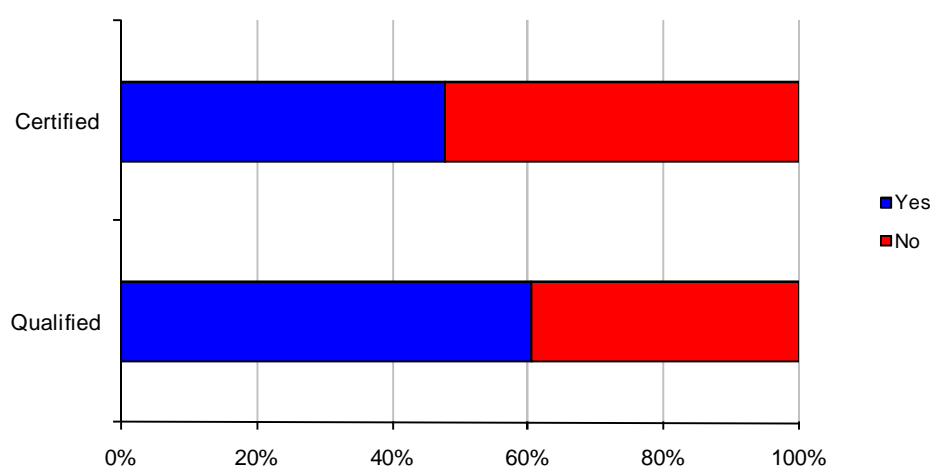

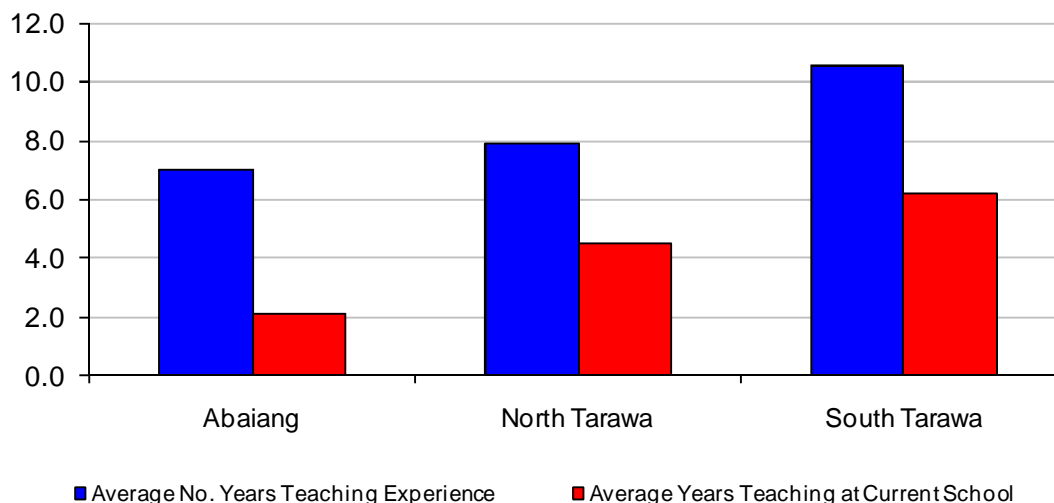

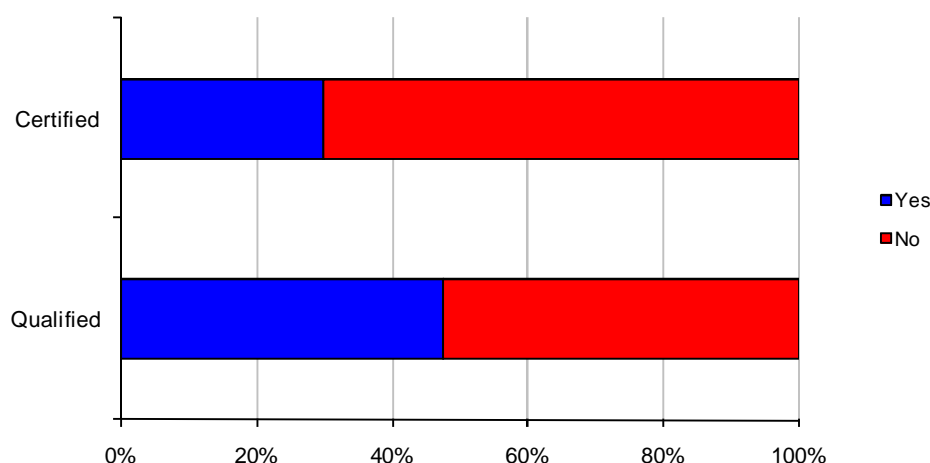

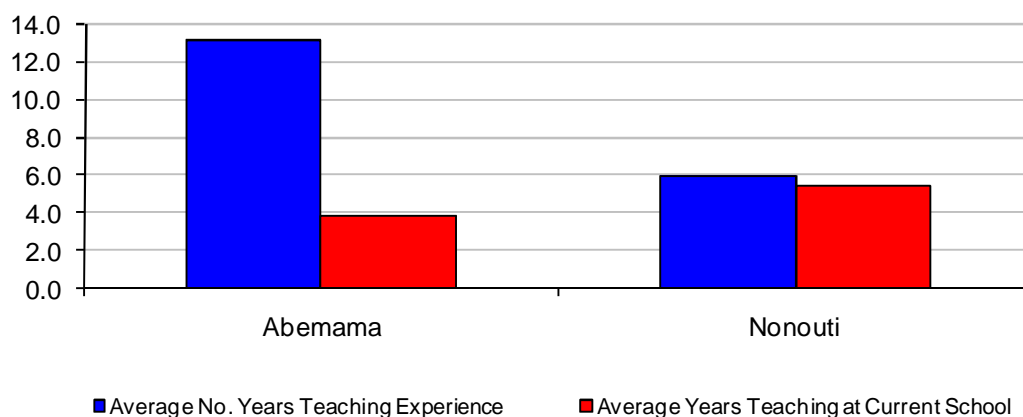

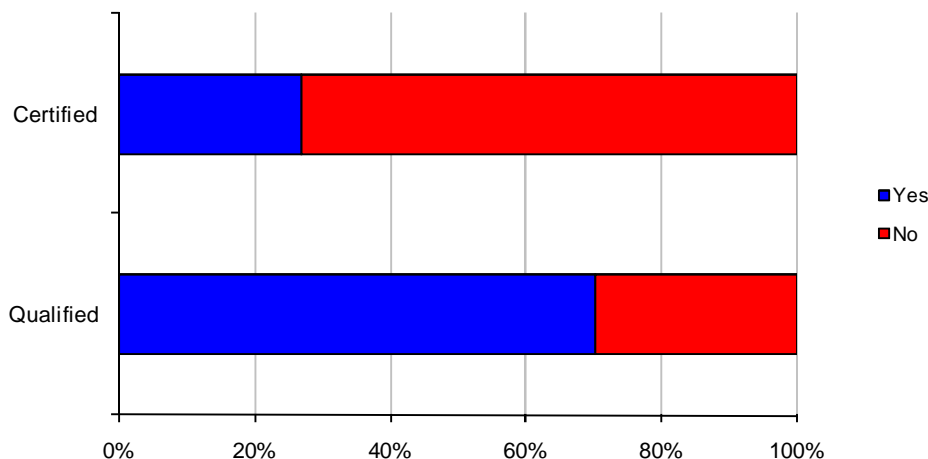

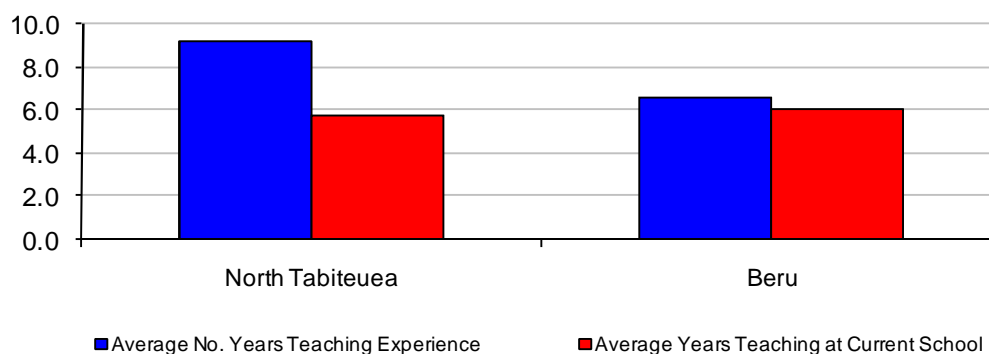
Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Senior Secondary Schools of District South.

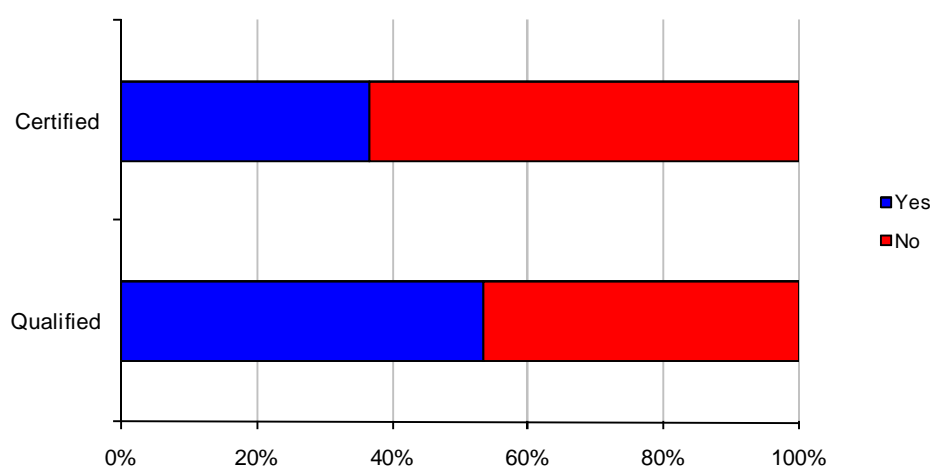

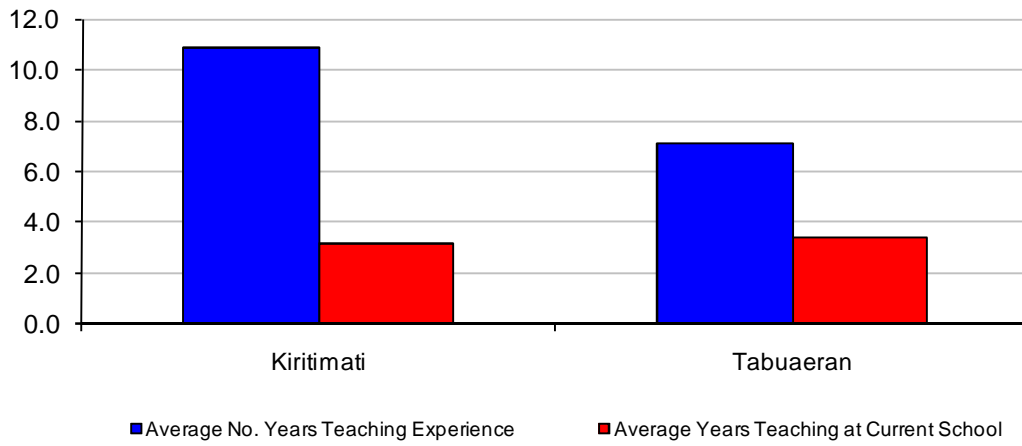
Proportion of Qualified and Certified Teachers in Senior Secondary Schools of Linnix District.

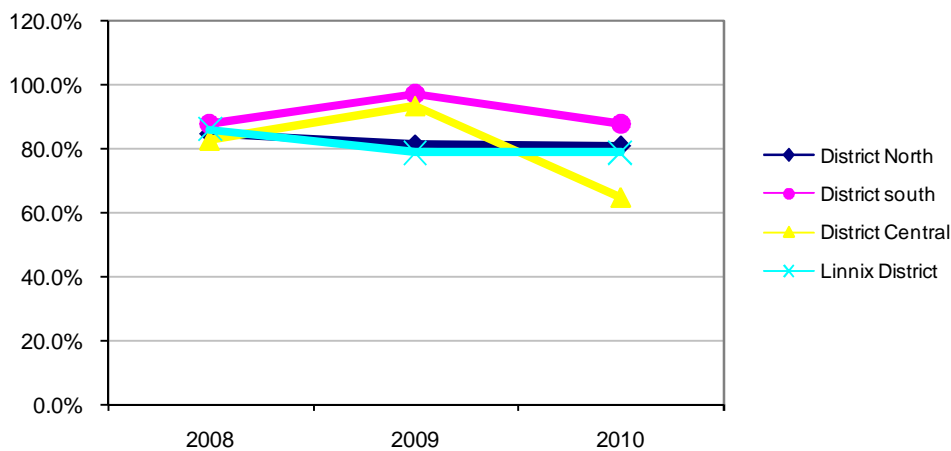

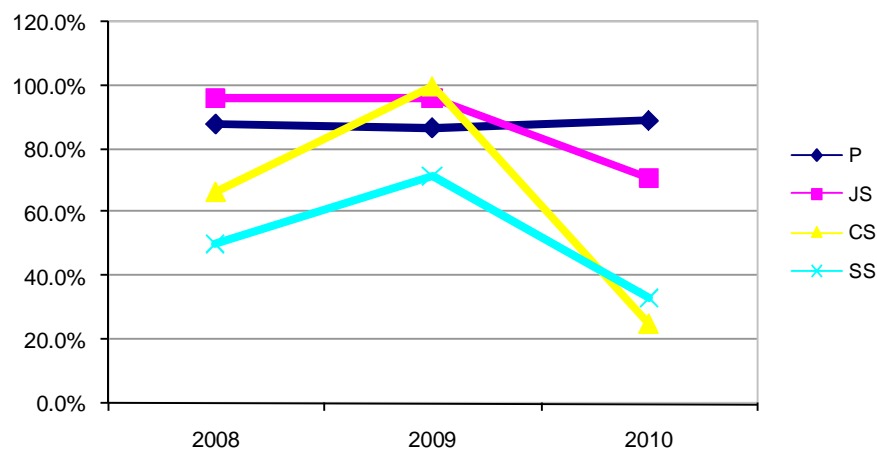

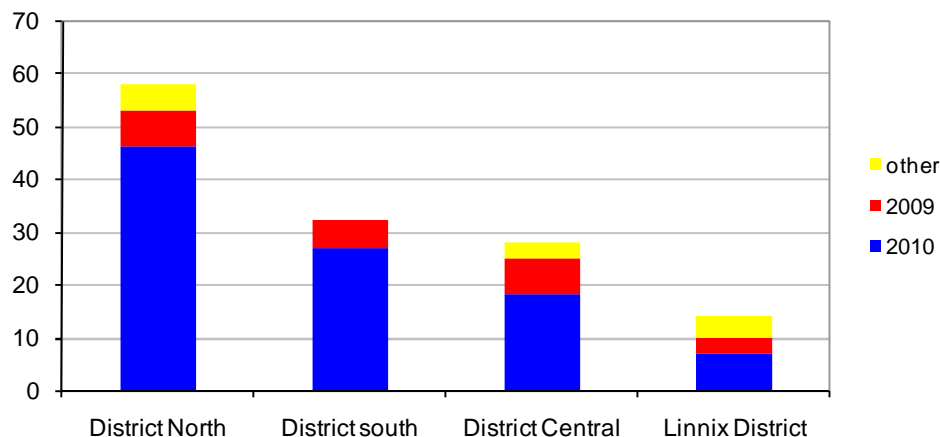
Schools Returning Survey By District, 2008 - 2010



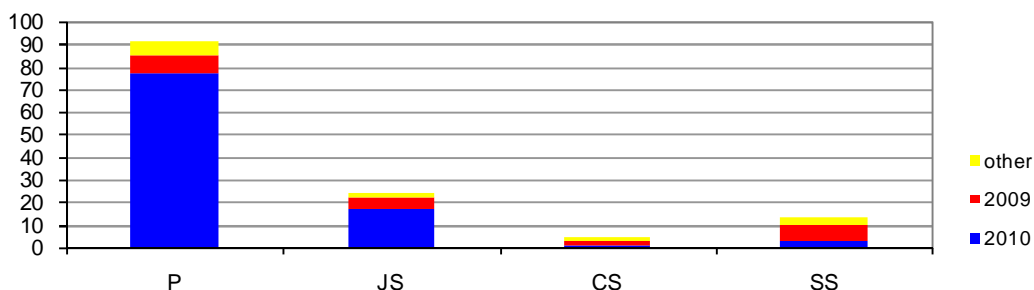
Schools Returning Survey By School Type, 2008 - 2010
