SOME USEFUL REFERENCES FOR ANIMAL PRODUCTION AND  
AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION WORKERS OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC COMMISSION TERRITORIES

At the Technical Meeting on Animal Health and Production which was held 5-14 July, 1966 in Suva, Fiji, and again at the Technical Meeting on Tropical Pastures and Beef Production, Brisbane 1969, it was recommended that the Commission prepare a list of books on Animal Husbandry, suitable for use in training in the Pacific area. It was further suggested that if none be available the Commission should consider the publication of suitable texts.

The latter would be a difficult, costly and long drawn out process. The Commission has therefore decided as an interim measure, to publish a list of References of general use for the teaching of Animal Production in the Tropics and Sub-tropics, which can be applied with advantage in the Pacific. In addition, there are included a few publications dealing with specific territories of the Region.

This is by no means a complete list and publications that have been omitted or are new will have to be added from time to time.
