### Session 9: Looking forward to and beyond 2025.

#### **Summary/Short description:**

Next year marks the final year of the current CBFM Framework for Action, and subsequently, it is timely to now bring together Pacific Islander practitioners in CBFM to share experiences and lessons learned. These experiences will assist with scaling up CBFM in the Pacific Islands region, identifying and prioritising key areas and associated priority actions.

At this stage of the workshop PICTs have explored the different aspects of scaling up CBFM and discussed progress in their countries. Participants should give a clear indication of one or two specific CBFM scaling areas they consider priorities for them to concentrate on in their work back home. This will be useful to guide their own work as well as partners for future planning.

Participants will also have had the opportunity to see if there are any major issues that have been overlooked but would be vital for scaling up CBFM or achieving coastal fisheries management.

This information will contribute to discussions on future policy directions for SPC and partners and it will be the basis for reporting to the Fisheries Ministers as part of the annual CBFM update at the Regional Fisheries Ministers Meeting
