



# Strategy 2021+: Drafting Committee Meeting 2 Brief

## Purpose

The Drafting Committee met on 2 September 2021 for its second meeting to:

1. Review feedback on the Key Focus Areas (KFAs) and the proposed structure of the Strategic Plan
2. Advise on engagement options to review drafts, including through full CRGA consultation, drop-in sessions and bilateral engagements
3. Share with members Secretariat presentations on the KFA backcasting workshops and on the development approach for the Strategic Results Framework.

## Attendance

1. Chaired by New Caledonia.
2. In attendance: Australia, Cook Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Fiji, French Polynesia, and the Secretariat's Senior Leadership Team.

## Highlights

The Drafting Committee:

1. Considered the consolidated feedback on the structure and definitions of KFA.
2. Noted the Secretariat's efforts to collaborate with other regional processes for the purpose of strengthening cohesion.
3. Expressed interest in participating in a backcasting exercise for the KFA 'Strengthening Institutional Effectiveness' to better understand the foresight approach being applied to all the KFAs during the next meeting of the Drafting Committee.
4. Discussed options to extend engagement outreach to the whole membership through multiple mechanisms including through the next drafting committee meeting, through drop-in sessions open to members and planning and sectoral nominees and through bilateral discussions.

5. Agreed to:

- a. Extend an invitation for the wider CRGA membership to attend the Drafting Committee meeting on 23 September.
- b. Offer a drop-in session for CRGA focal points and nominees on the drafting of the Strategic Plan.
- c. Include the strategic plan as part of the planned briefing activities prior to CRGA.
- d. Include the Strategic Plan as part of the scheduled CRGA 51 pre-briefing.

## Next Steps

1. Secretariat to send a circular to CRGA to update on Drafting Committee activities and to invite participation in the drafting of the Strategic Plan.
2. Secretariat to respond to request for bilateral engagements and to support Drafting Committee members with sub-regional engagements.
3. Meeting 3 to be held on Thursday 23 September.
