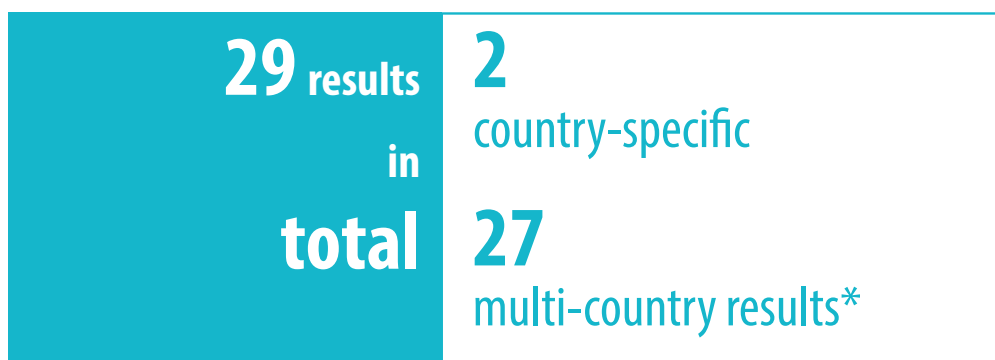

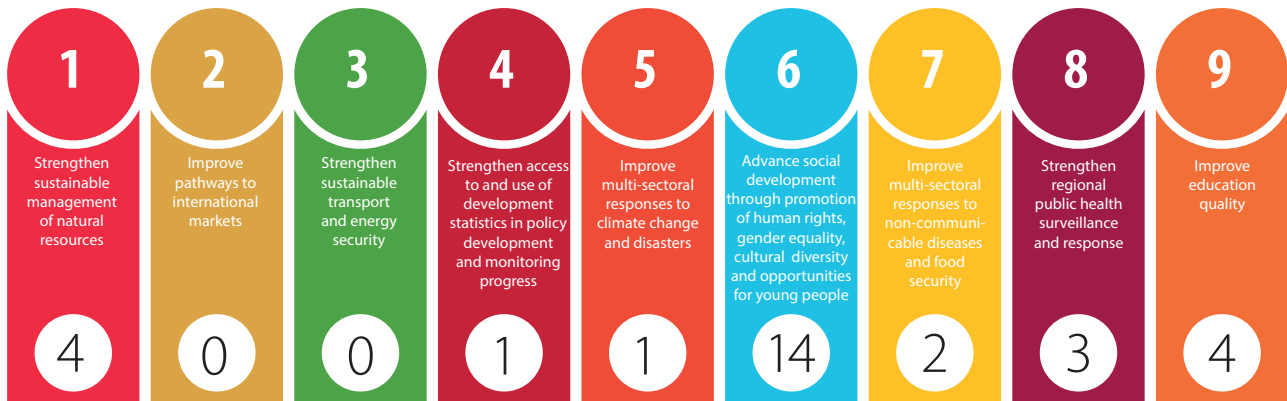
Results Summary 2018

Each year, as part of SPC's organisation-wide annual results reporting process, SPC collates the results achieved in each of its member countries and territories, and in the region. In 2018, 588 results were reported across the organisation towards the achievement of our objectives. Of these results, 2 country-specific results were reported for Nauru, with an additional 27 multi-country results benefitting Nauru.

SPC's staff supported Nauru in achieving its results in three ways:







SPC's contribution to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals






In 2018, we mapped each result to the SDGs to show how SPC contributes to their achievement in each of our member countries and territories. In Nauru, results contributed to 9 of the 17 SDGs. The highest number of results supported SDG 16: Peace, justice and strong institutions, followed by SDG 5: Gender equality. One result may contribute to multiple SDGs.


