WORLD VISION INTERNATIONAL

Types of assistance: World Vision is a Christian humanitarian organisation, with 65,000 supporters, which does relief and medium and long-term development in developing countries. World Vision provides technical and material assistance, working mainly through Christian agencies or its own offices in the fields of child care, health medicine, agriculture, regional community development and relief.

Types of assistance: The World YWCA supports the activities of its more than 80 autonomous national associations. Each conducts a wide range of programmes aimed at raising the status of women and more fully integrating them into development processes. The world headquarters in Geneva serves as a link between world-wide membership and their activities and international donors.

Application: World YWCA funds mainly member organisations. Requests for financial assistance must go through the National YWCA. In the Pacific there are YWCAs in Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, Fiji, Samoa and Tonga.
