DIGITISATION vs DIGITALISATION

- Digitisation is the process of converting data and information from a physical (paper) format to a digital one
 - entering the details from a registration book into a computer software program
- It only refers to the data or information being digitised, not the processes leading up to its collection

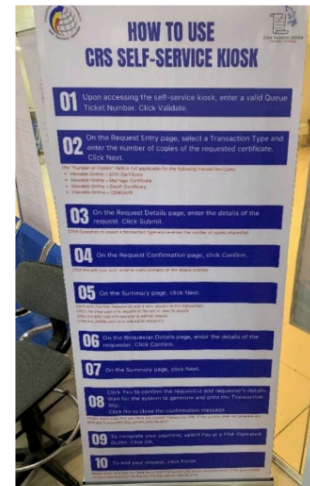
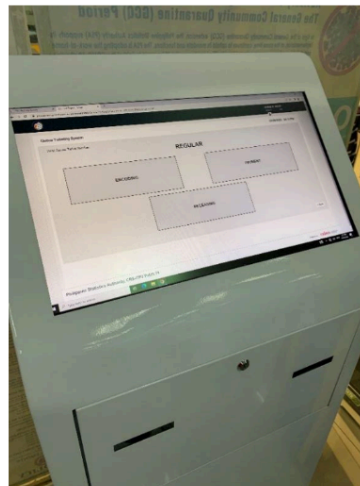

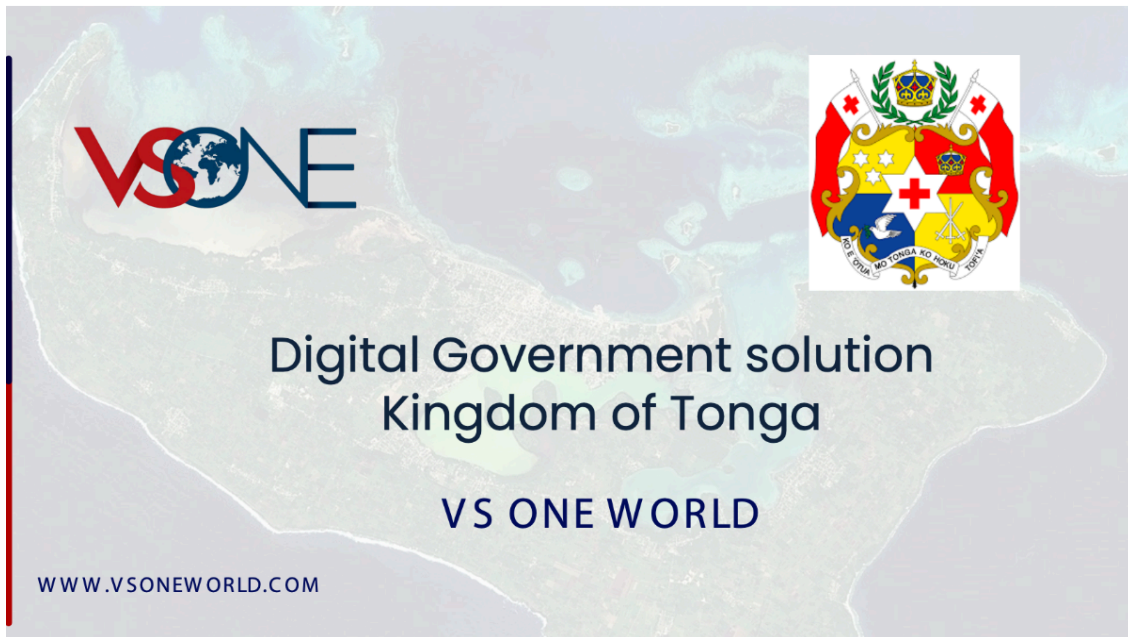
