3. Indonesia has recently revised the proportion of catch taken by gear type for their domestic fisheries which has resulted in a much larger allocation to their longline (at the expense of catches in the "unclassified" fisheries) since 2004 than has been reported in previous years.
4. Catches and effort of vessels operating under charters and similar arrangements have been attributed to host island states or territories in accordance with paragraph 5 of CMM 2005-01 using the best information available to SPC-OFP.

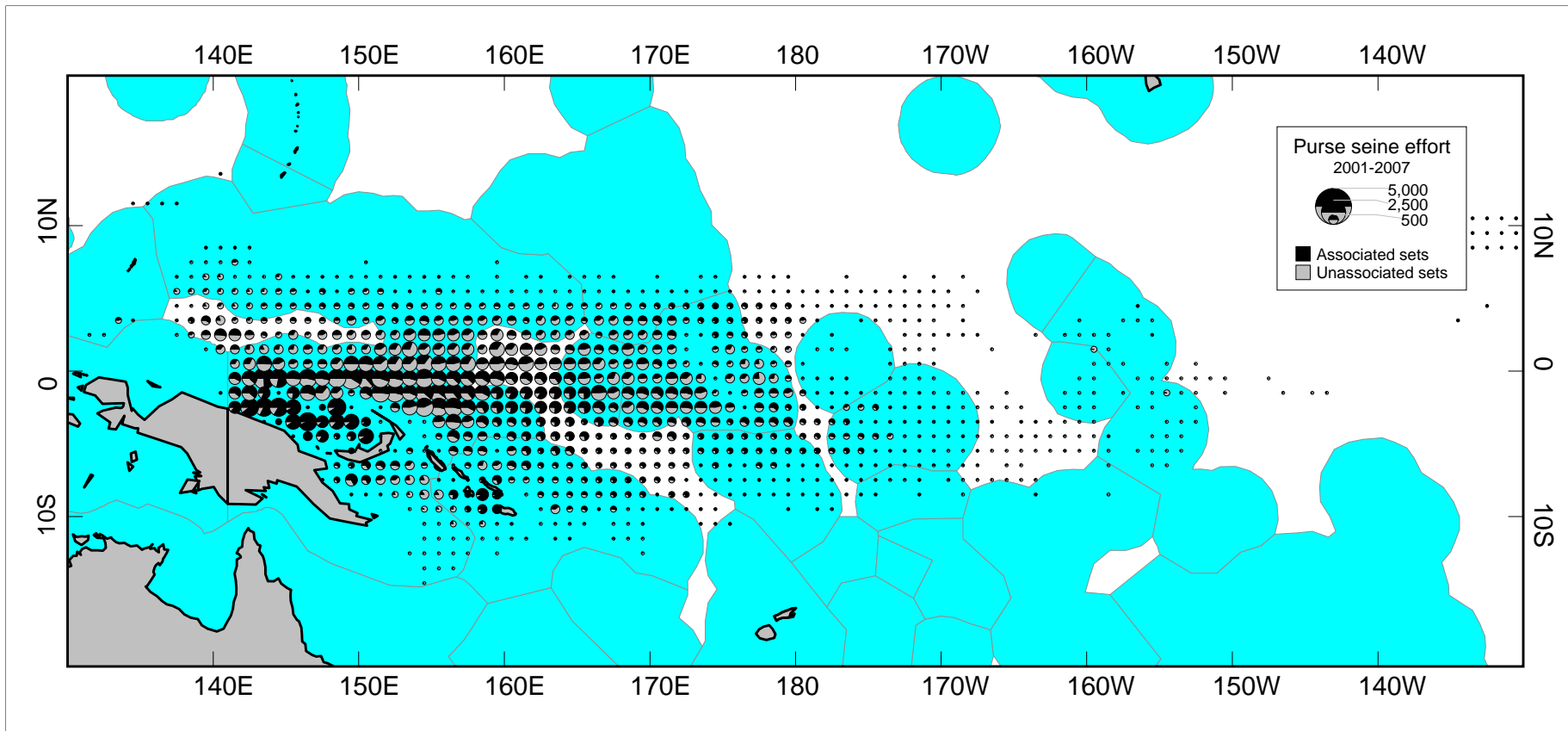


Figure 1: Distribution of purse seine effort in the WCPFC by set type for 2001-2007.

Estimated catches of swordfish in the WCPFC-CA south of 20S

There is no requirement under the current SWO CMM to report catch for the area covered by the measure. The estimates of SWO catch are based on overall catch estimates and aggregate longline catch data. For 2007, aggregate data is not available for many fleets.

The table below provides the current best estimates of SWO catch with footnotes outlining any assumptions or issues. We note that for some flags these numbers could differ from their annual catch estimates, but efforts were made to use a standard method across flags.

¹ Aggregate data were provided 10 December 2008 and these data have been included in this table for 2007 and represent a small difference from the preliminary estimates provided to SC-4.

² Catch in weight are not provided in the aggregate data. Therefore, catch in weight is estimated by applying a monthly average weight from available logsheet data to the catch in numbers. Japan has indicated that it will submit aggregate catch in weight to the Commission to allow more accurate estimation of their catches. Therefore these figures are preliminary and subject to change.

⁴ As all NZ fishing is south of 20S, the use of aggregate data is not appropriate due to the raising methodology used by SPC-OFP. The revised estimates are the annual catch estimates provided to the WCPFC.
