BACKGROUND

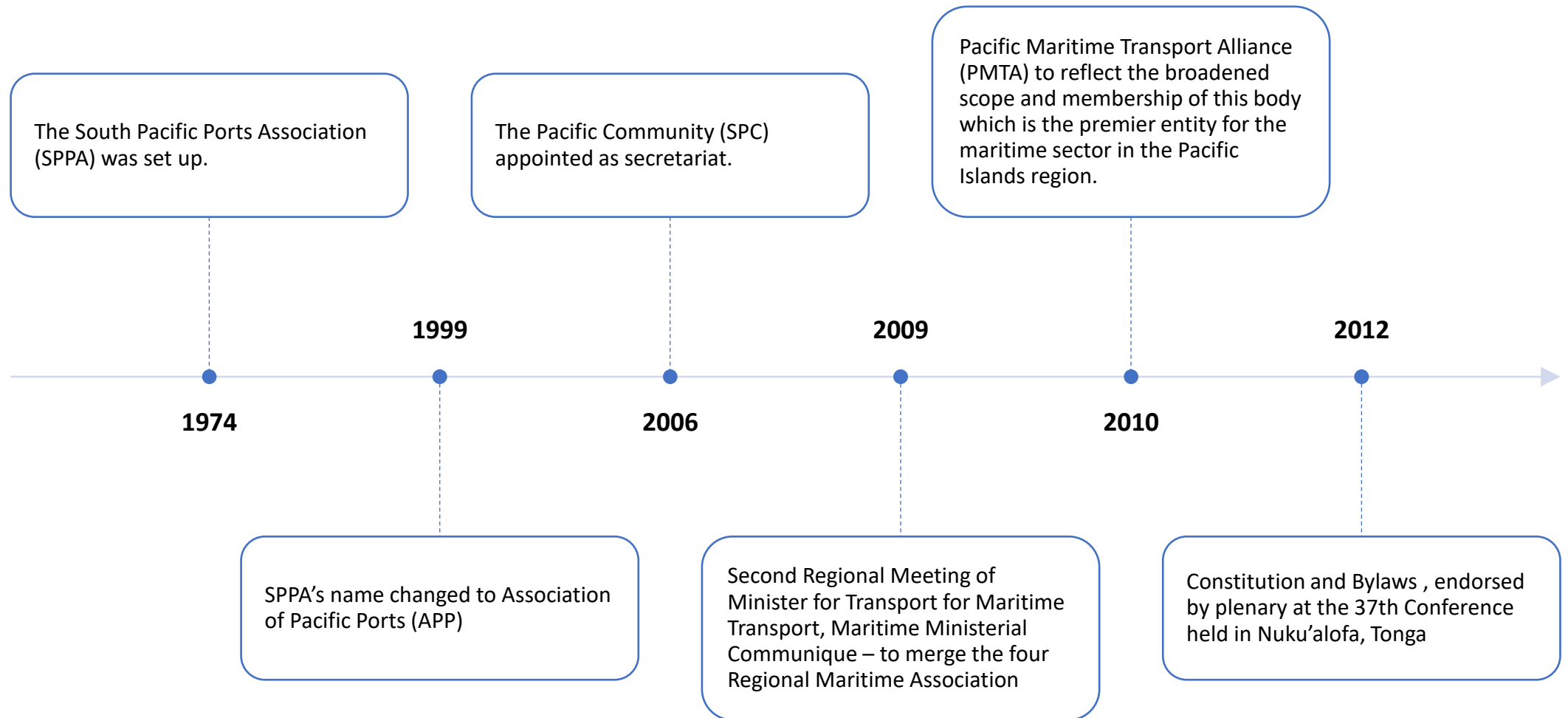


Pacific Maritime Transport Alliance (PMTA)

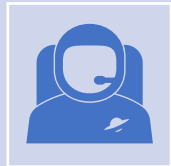

The promotion of regional cooperation, friendship, exchange of knowledge and the dissemination of information useful to maritime transport regulators, trainers and operators.



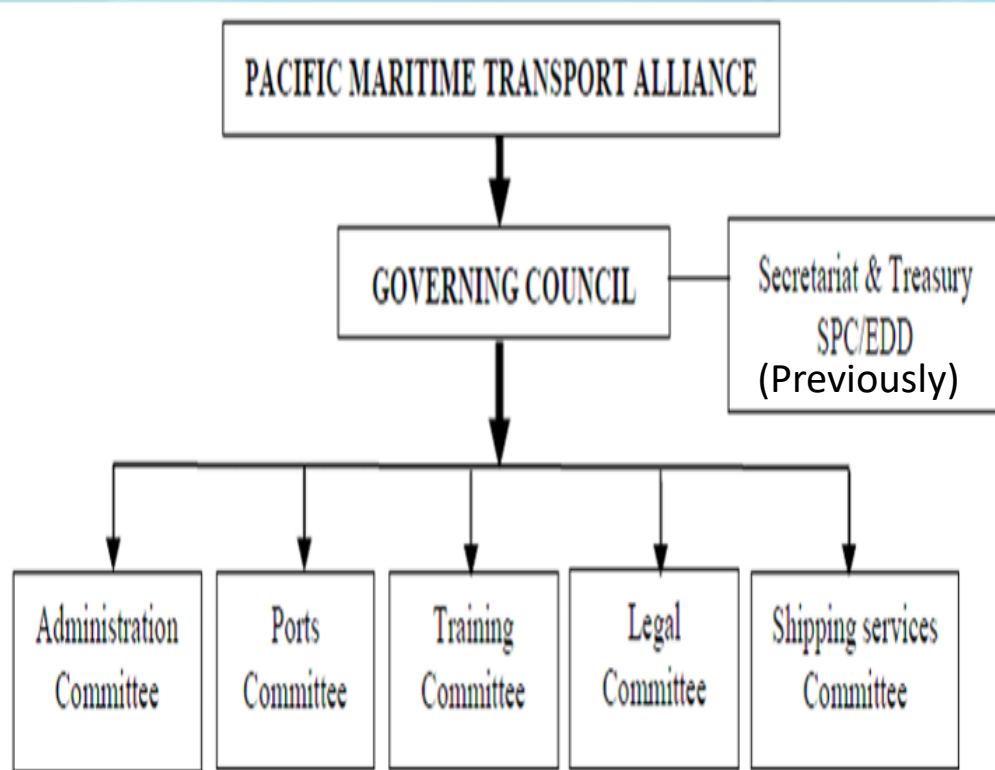
